Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 4th June 2020, 3.00 pm

A meeting of the members of the IQAC was held on 4th June 2020 through google meet with the following agenda

- Online classes in the new scenario
- NAAC accreditation
- Students Feed back on syllabus and institution

Meeting expressed happiness as we can start the online classes in full swing as the college was well equipped with internet connectivity in the classes. Meeting urged the teachers to make the online classes interactive. Meeting discussed the issue of the non-availability of electronic gadgets for many students. Meeting decided to seek the support of the retired teachers and other well-wishers for providing students with electronic devices. It is reported that many teachers are recharging the mobile connections of the students who are finding it difficult. Also, students from Lakshadweep find it challenging to attend online classes, and it is suggested to share the recordings of the online classes.

The meeting discussed the feedback of the students regarding the syllabus. One of the significant suggestions of the students was to use ICT more widely. As the college has completed connecting all the classes through a wired network, the meeting observed that we have a perfect platform for the implementation of more ICT tools. Meeting decided to seek the support of alumni and retired teachers for upgrading more classrooms into smart classrooms. Meeting also decided to seek the help of external agencies upgrading classes into IT-enabled places. Also, it is determined to seek the support of external agencies to purchase more computers. Meeting decided to forward the report on the syllabus to the University, as the college cannot do much with the syllabus. The meeting also discussed the student survey report and suggested improving the physical ambience at the college.

The meeting indicated that it would be good if the Principal could interact with students directly.

As the operations at the college have not come into full swing, it was decided to wait for the condition to be normal before proceeding to the NAAC accreditation. Also, it is decided to concentrate more on teaching as the classes are online. The success of the college should be continued in delivering effective classes even during the COVID pandemic period. Urged all faculty

members to make the classes more attractive as students have to adapt to the new situation.

Meeting opinioned that more webinars should be organized this covid time. IQAC requested all departments to take the initiatives to have more webinars this year. Meeting decided to organize at least one webinar once in two months.

During the pandemic period, we won't be able to have face to face extension activities. Hence it has been decided to continue the extension activities by creating more awareness videos and audio clips.

- 1. The meeting was held on the virtual platform presided by the Principal, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Stephy Thomas, Secretary to the Arch Diocese of Kottayam and the IQAC members.
- 2. The meeting commenced with a silent prayer.
- 3. The IQAC coordinator welcomed the gathering and called on the Principal to give the introductory remarks. The principal, in her introductory speech highlighted the importance and awareness how of the NEP would be implemented and the changes necessary to be incorporated to accommodate the same.
- 4. Meeting decided to organize a webinar on National Education Policy 2020.

- 8. Discussions were held, and it was proposed to conduct a programme under the nomenclature "Chat With Experts."
- 9. The chat with experts by students was to be treated as a query platform to answer questions by experts on the programmes of study, job opportunities, specializations etc.
- 10. It was decided that each department would set up a series of questions from the angle of students to be asked and answered.

- 11. The session should have a provision where students could put in their queries through the chatbox.
- 12. The IQAC members suggested that parents also be involved in the proposed session.
- 13. A suggestion to provide a link for registration among the students and parents and only those who have registered would be admitted for the programme was also given.
- 14. It was decided in the meeting to hold this initiative for students and parents virtually on 18.8.2020 (Tuesday) at 2.00 pm.
- 15. Also, as part of NIRF, the institution's perception from the public will be collected, and such a programme will enhance the perception of the institution.
