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
I. ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE


II. SEMINARS / WORKSHOPS / WEBINARS




b) BUSINESS AFTER COVID-19

The Seminar was started by prayer then followed by an introduction section conducted by the head of the department Prof. Jipin V. Jimmy [organizer of the seminar].




a) MEET THE WOMEN 2020




Life journey of Dr. Divya S. Iyer stimulated students and created a sense of endeavour in the minds of students.




DAY 4 : Sindhu Sooryakumar – Assistant executive Editor


DAY 5 : Tintu Luka - Sports athelete

recipient of Arjuna award was the chief guest.






3. STATE LEVEL

a) WEBINAR ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY



Supporting and celebrating women's rights is a year round responsibility. But on International Women's day which is on march 8 2021,this year is even more important to take a stand for women's equality.




Even though, the programmes were lasted only for one hour and it was a grand success. The celebration will be a remarkable achievement in the history of Commerce Department of BCM Colleg







A recurring deposit is a special kind of term deposit offered by banks which help people with regular incomes to deposit a fixed amount every month into their recurring deposit account and earn interest at the rate applicable to fixed deposits. It is similar to making fixed deposits of a certain amount in monthly instalments. This deposit matures on a specific date in the future along with all the deposits made every month.

The students of Commerce Department has initiated in opening a recurring deposit account. The main aim of this initiative is to maintain an account for the purpose of gathering money for their final year entertainment tour. 
6. E-COMMERCE ANALYSIS

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1. INTERACTIVE SESSIONS


a) ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROMOTION POLICIES

On 20th October , department of commerce (SF) conducted webinar on "Different entrepreneurship promotion policies for women" as a part of celebrating entrepreneurship day.


Aiswarya K.M (association secretary) delivered the welcome speech followed by presidential address by Dr. VS Jose (head of the department SF).




b) SPSS




✤ DAY 3: Tiffiny Brar- Indian Community Service worker

DAY 4 : Sindhu Sooryakumar – Assistant executive Editor








2. LECTURE SERIES






4. STUDENT ENTREPRENUERS
