Quiz Competition

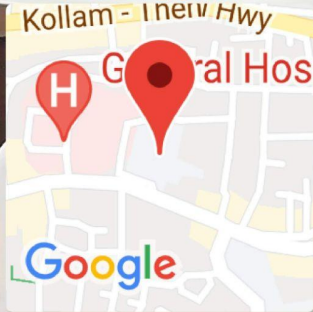

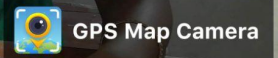
