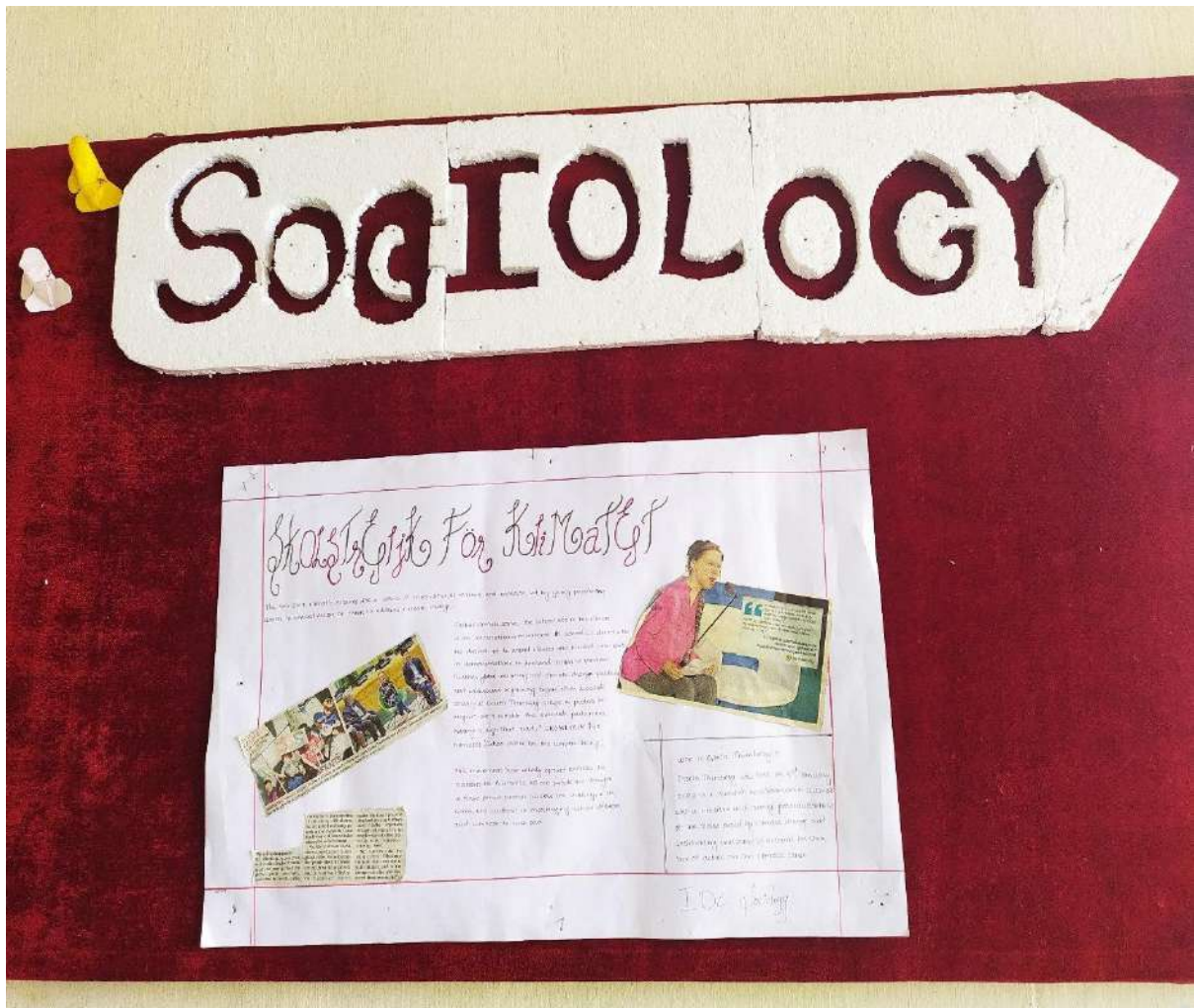
GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS CLASS

A series of discussions were held over the months in intra and interdepartmental level on various burning social issues like legalization of adultery , evaluation of demonetization and so on



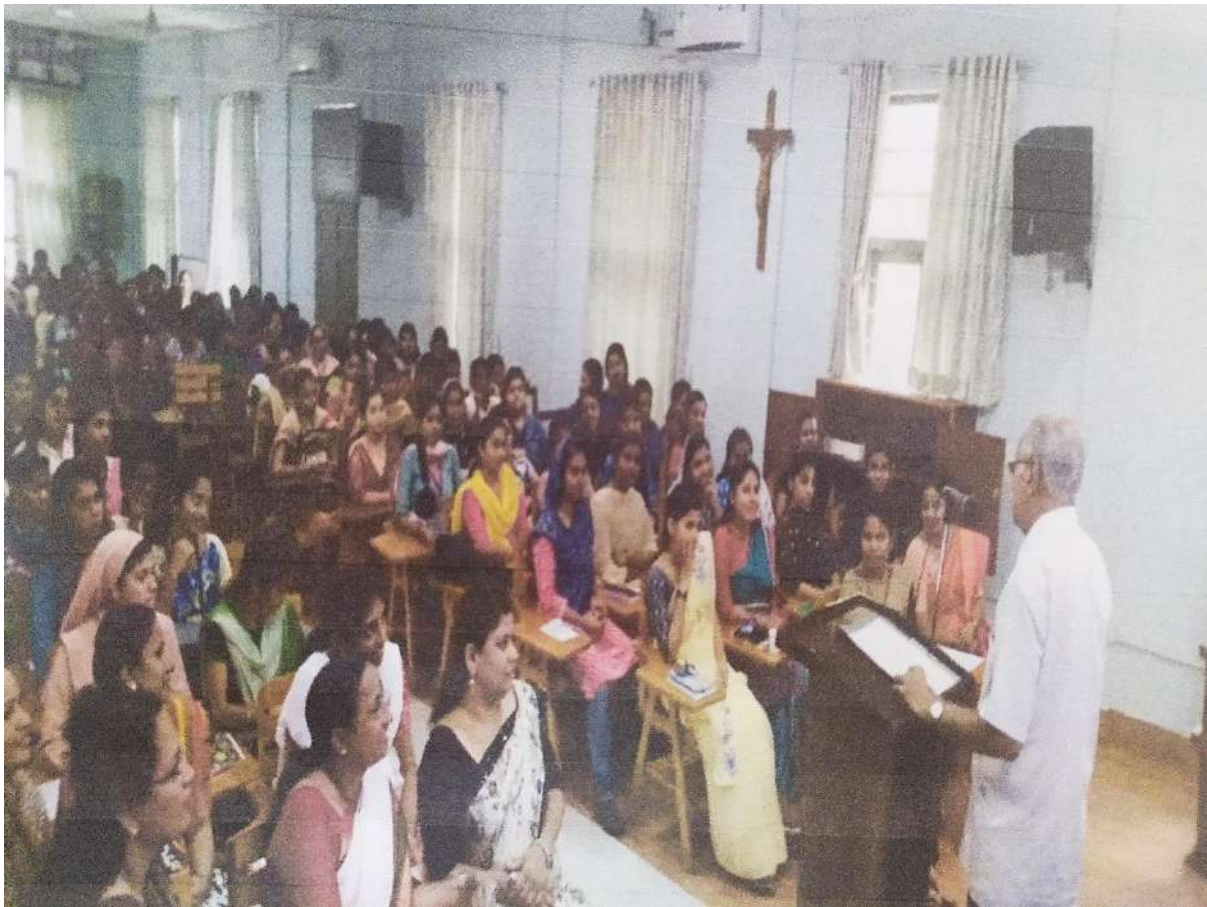
SELF DEFENCE CLASS : G . C . I Devika

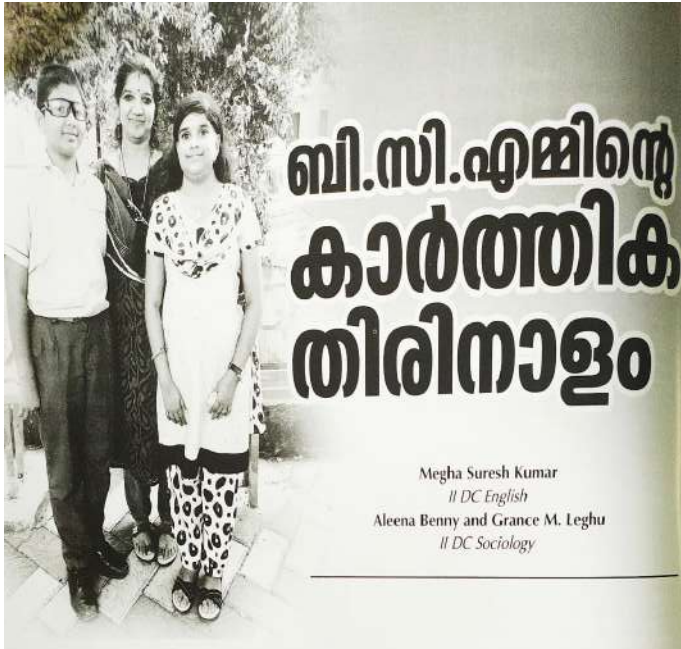

I will be smiling but this bleeds my heart

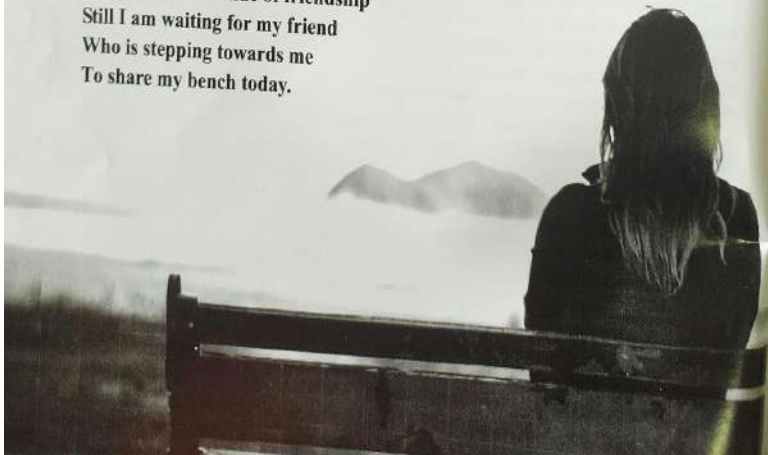
When I wake up in the morning

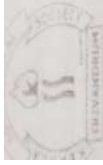

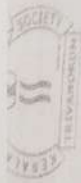
