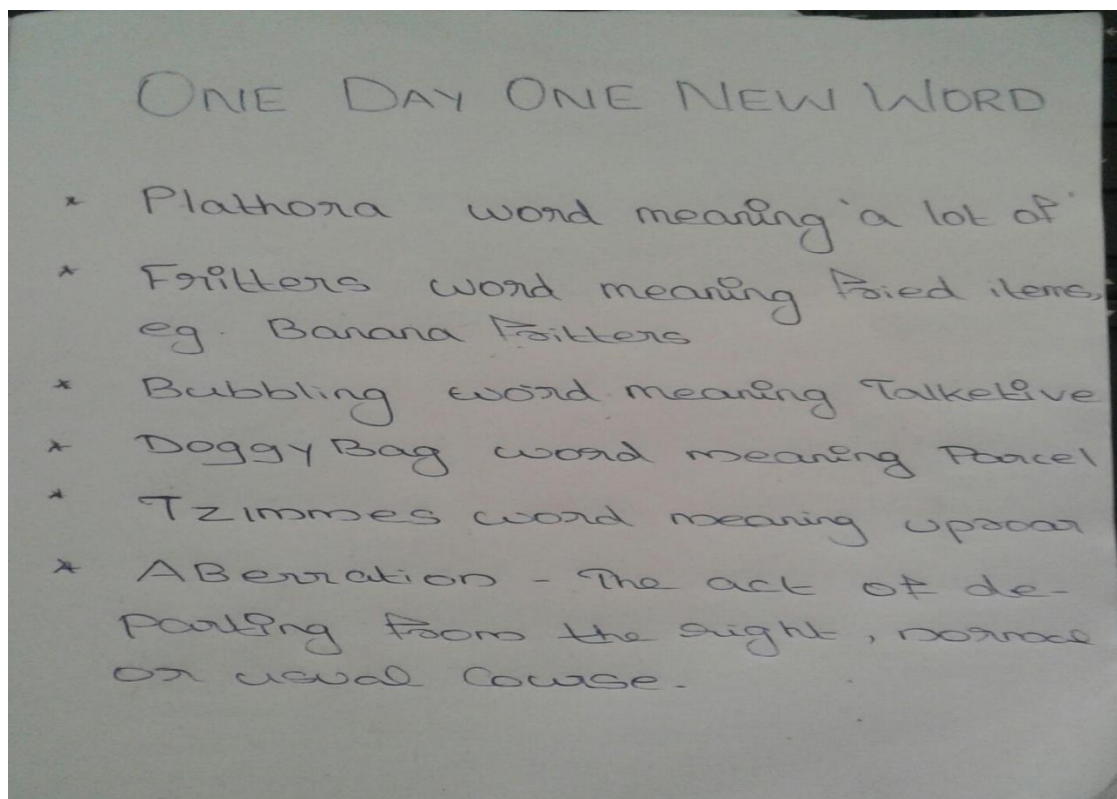
- On 19-06-2018-**Reading** day-department organized a programme called “**NINAVU**” under which more
