

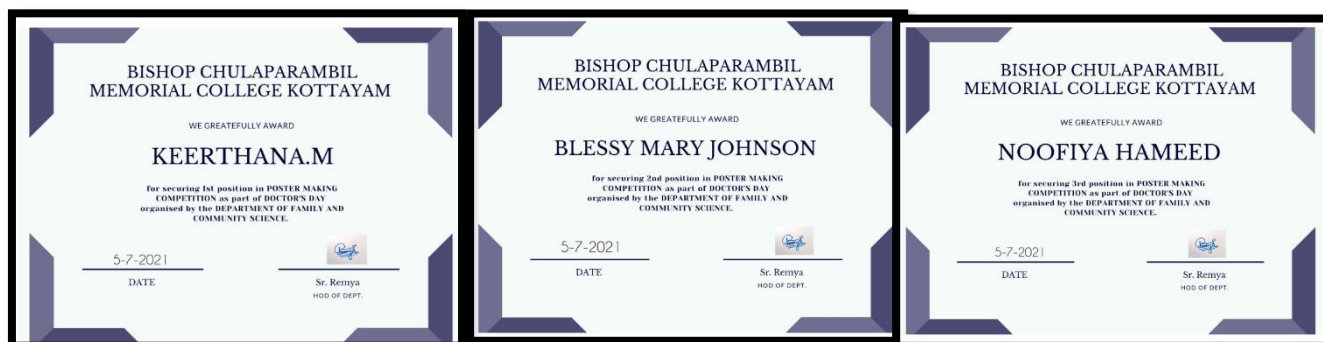
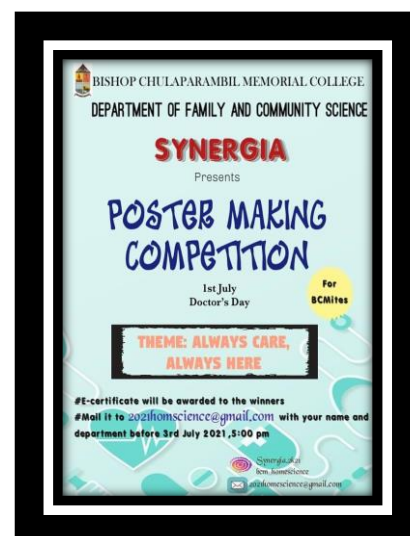
MONTH OF JULY

- The second year students made a video on the pros and cons of population growth.



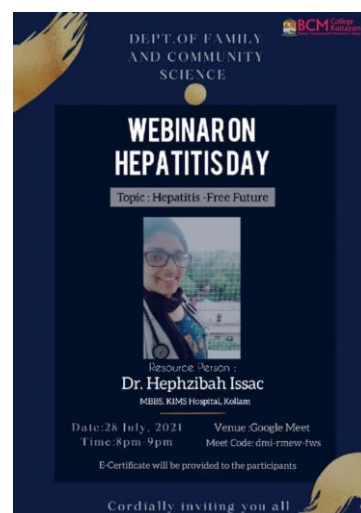
Winners of this competition was
