VEHICLE POLICY

Eligibility

Any faculty/staff (both teaching and non-teaching) of Bishop Chulaparambil Memorial College, currently working on campus are eligible for campus parking facilities unless such privileges have been revoked. Vehicle registration numbers and the names of the staffs availing such privileges should be given to the Security Officer at the beginning of each academic year.

Policy

- The teaching and non-teaching staff and the students are encouraged to use the public transport system at least once per month mandatorily, that is, on the third day of the fourth week of every month.
- Vehicle pooling should be a regular practice to protect the environment and contribute to low carbon emissions.
- 3. Encourage staff and students to use bicycles.
- Students' vehicles are not permitted inside the campus to make the campus more pedestrian-friendly.
- 5. The college has separate entry and exit pathways to facilitate the movement of vehicles.
- There is a parking provision for our staff and visitors. However, our criteria for allocating parking area can change depending on the days when special functions occur within the campus.
- 7. A few restrictions are set in place for vehicle owners:



- > The front entrance is not to be blocked.
- > Parking spaces reserved for the differently-abled should be left free.
- > Speeding, turning carelessly and driving irresponsibly is prohibited because there are several educational institutions on campus.

During working hours, vehicles are prohibited from using the way down, along the front of the auditorium towards the hostel premises, so that disturbance to classes can be prevented.
