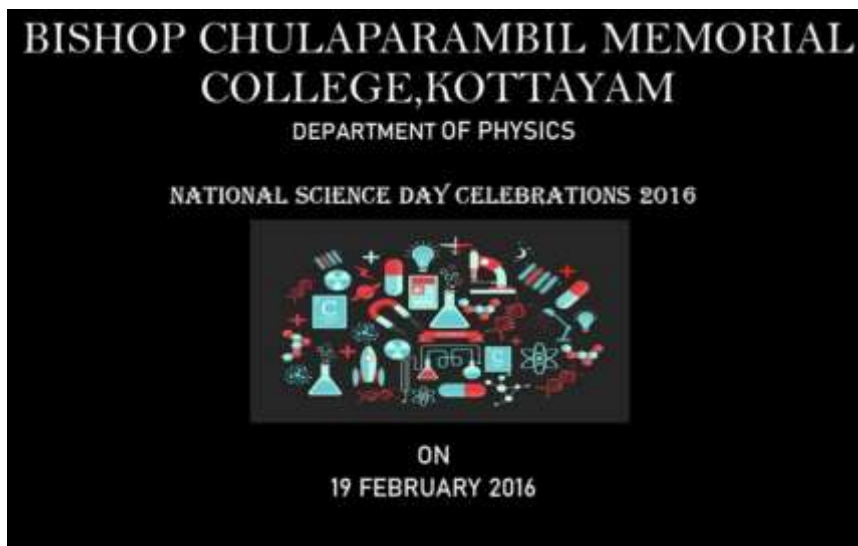

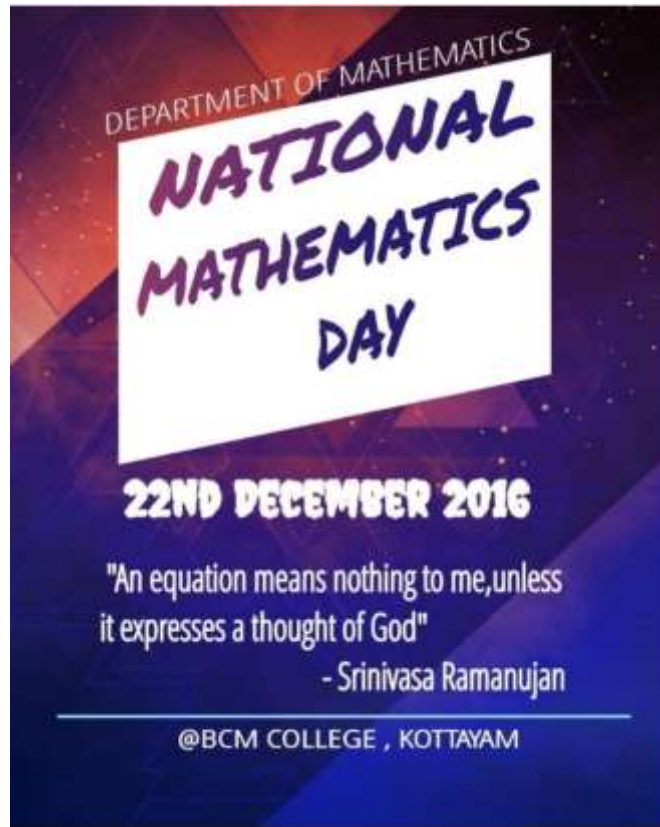
WORLD HEALTH DAY OBSERVED AT

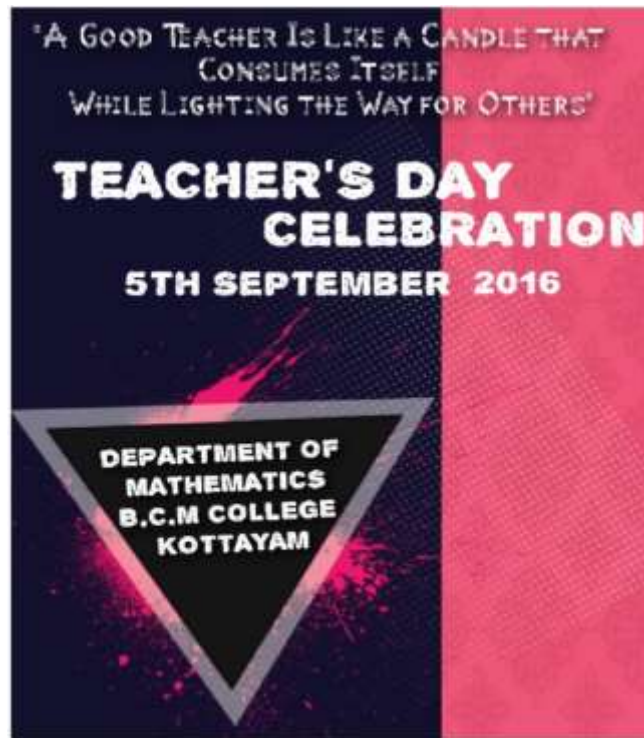

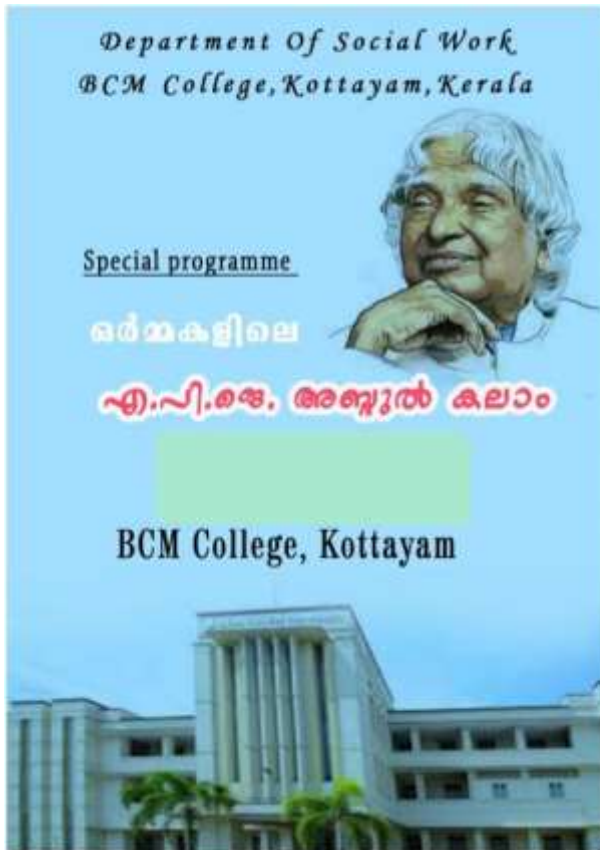

public places.

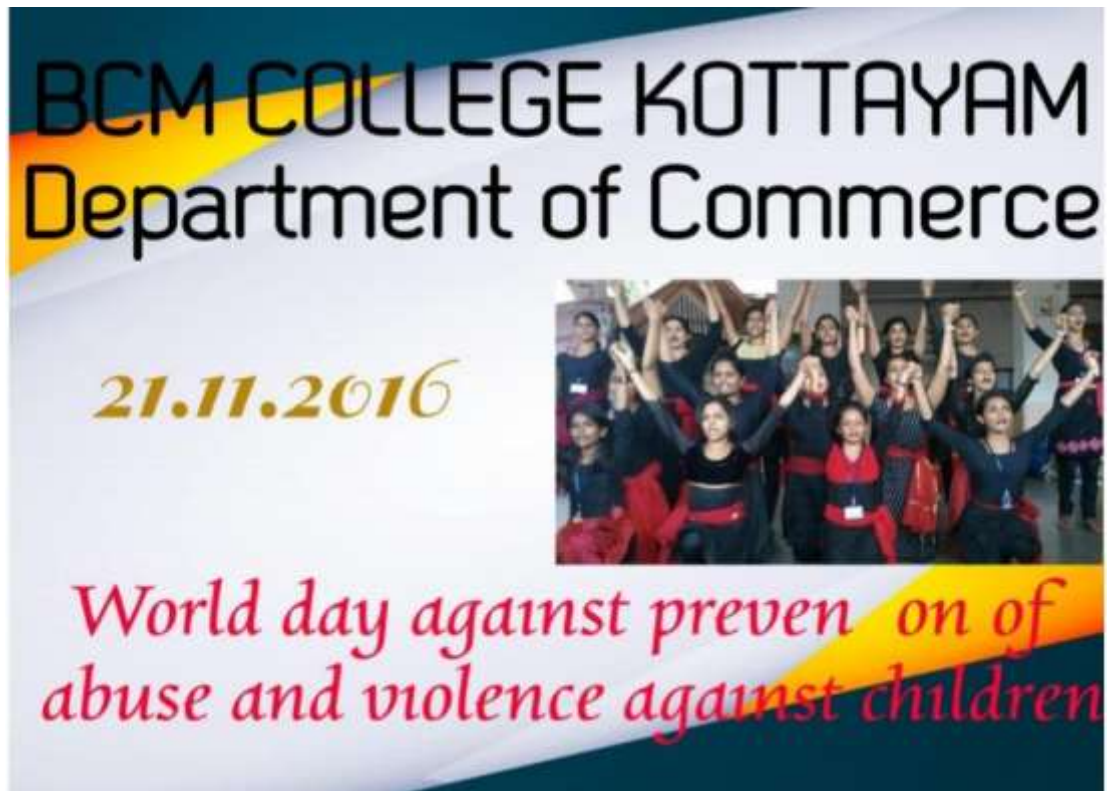
The entire programme was organized by networking

MINERVA celebrated Christmas in pomp and galore. HOD Josephina Simon delivered the



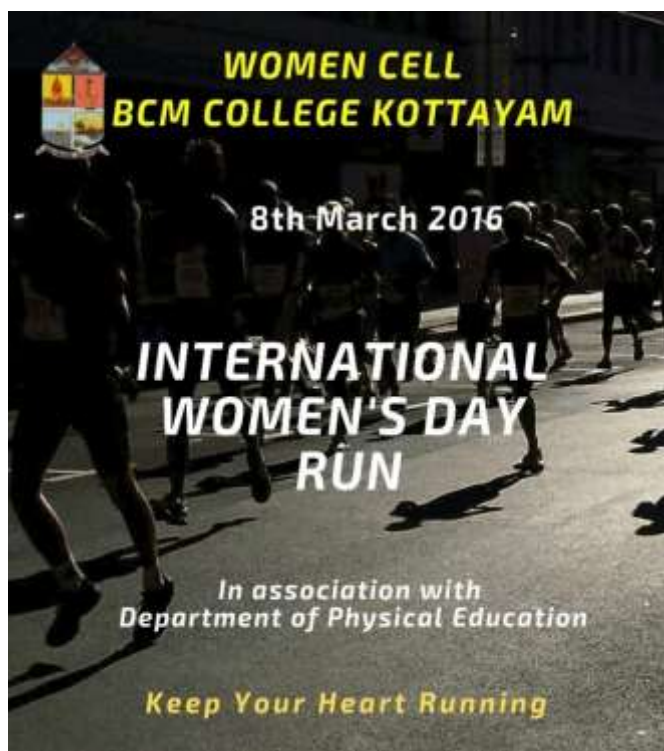
message and Carol, Santa, Christmas Skit and Christmas cakes turned out to be the star attractions.

CENTRAL EXCISE DAY



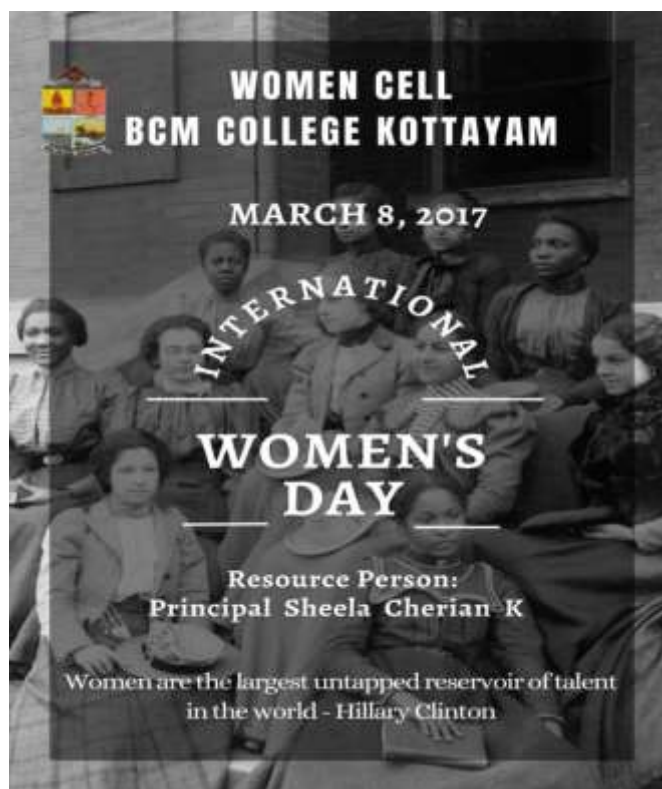

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY



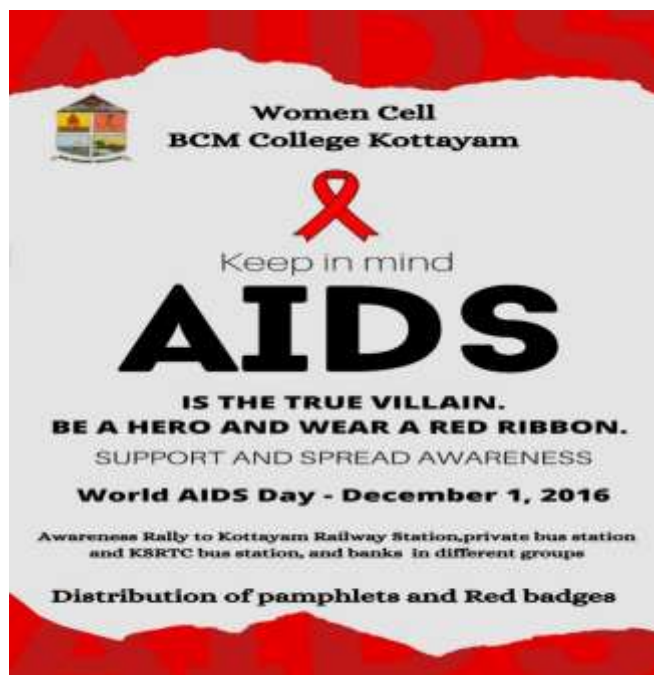
Our students of Women Cell Unit of BCM College Kottayam were part of the international women's day run conducted by the department of physical education in association with women's day on March 8th
