NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY

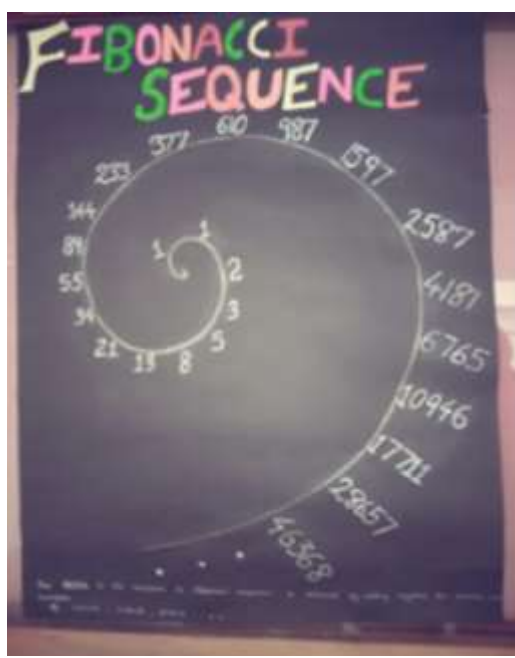

FIBONACCI DAY

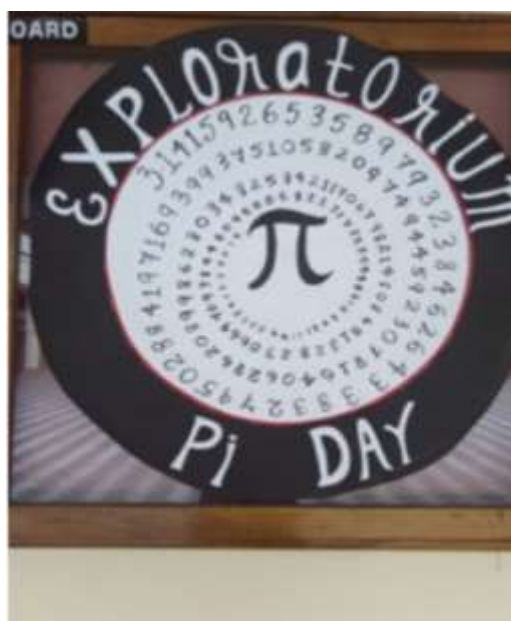

ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION

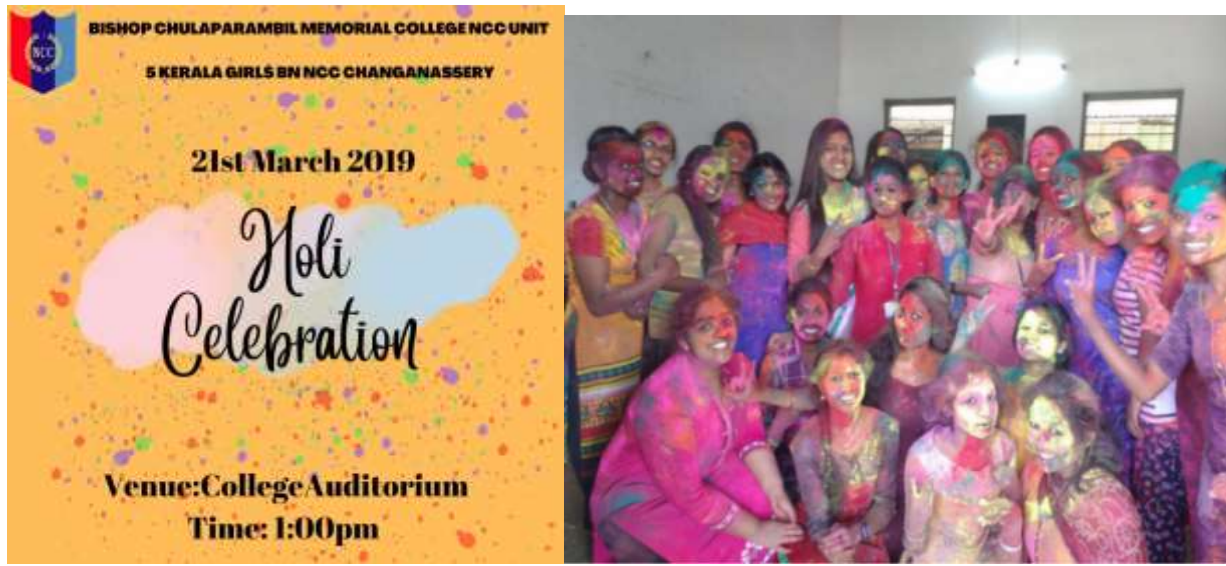

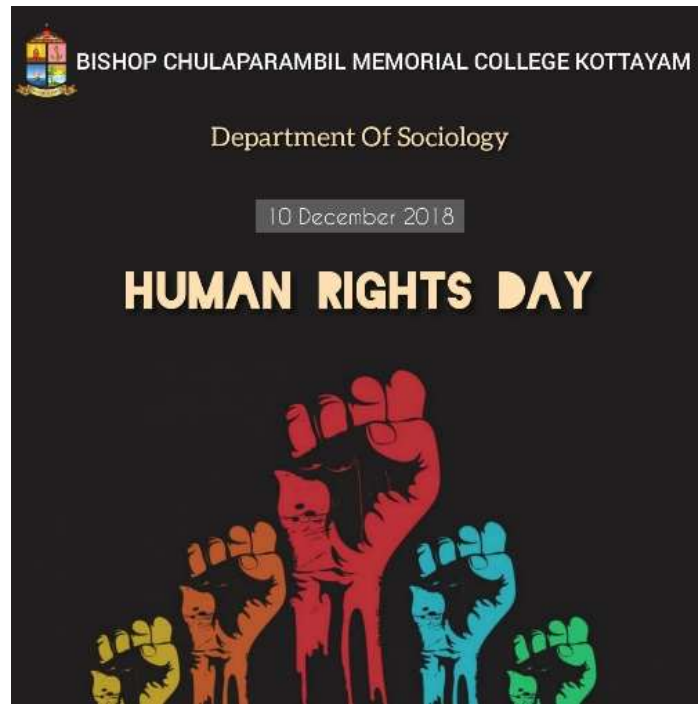


HOLI CELEBRATION

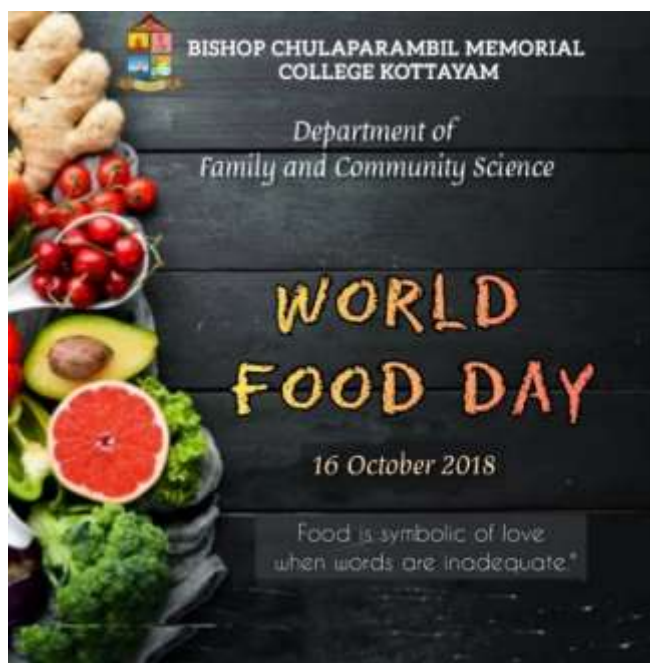
HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

WORLD FOOD DAY

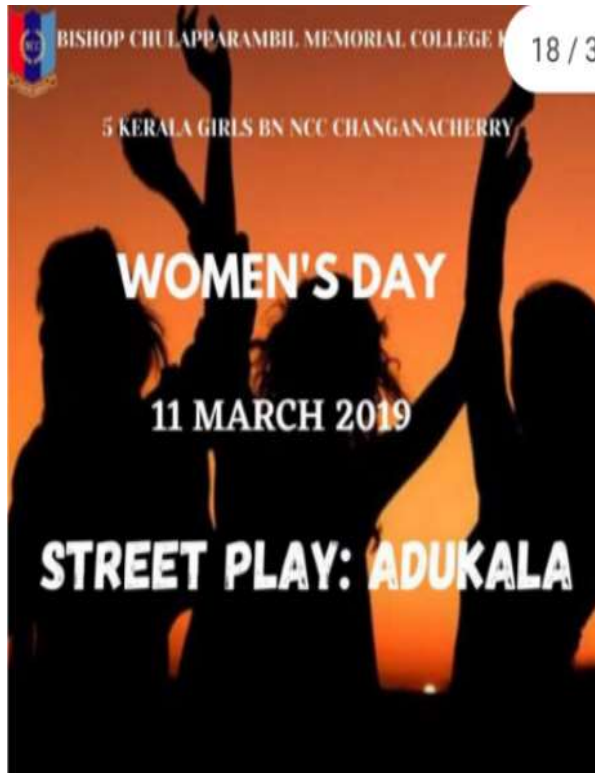

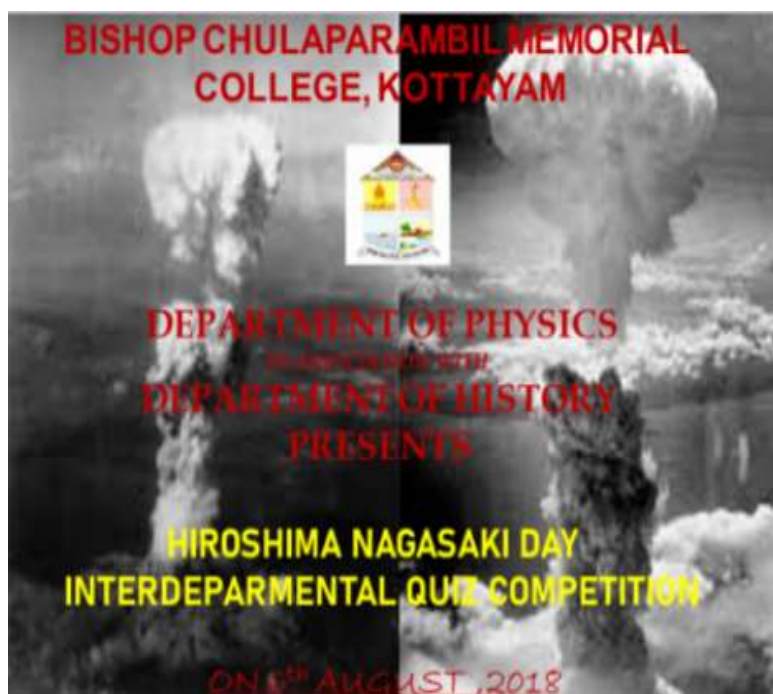


MALALA DAY

WORLD MIGRATORY BIRD DAY

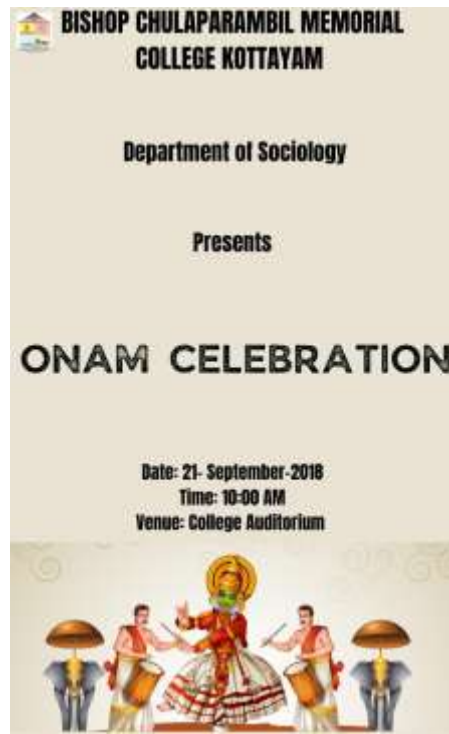

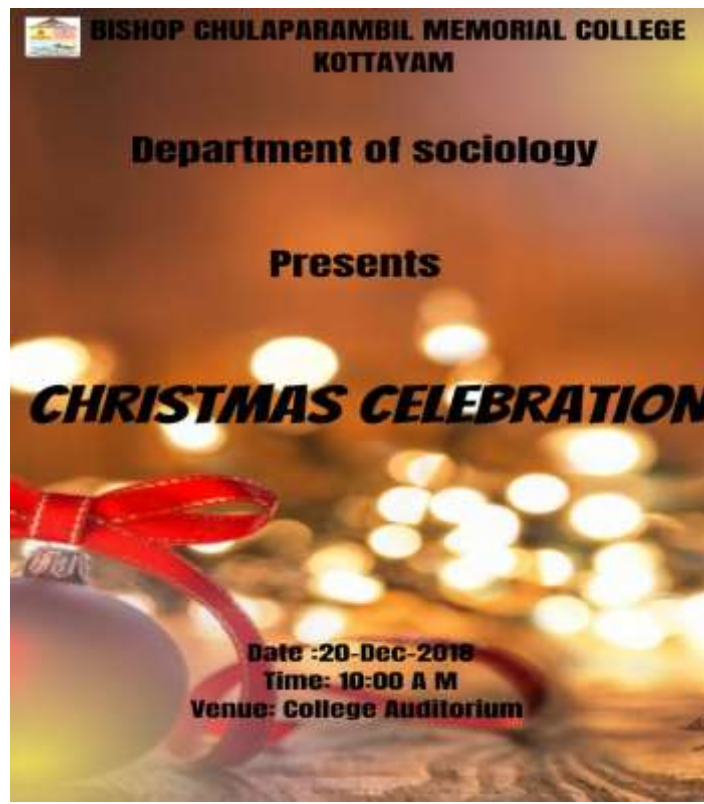


ONAM CELEBRATION

WORLD ALZHEIMER'S DAY



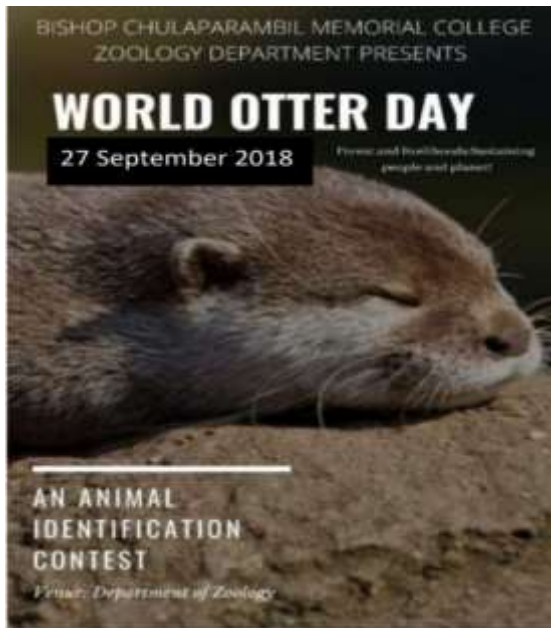

ETHNIC DAY



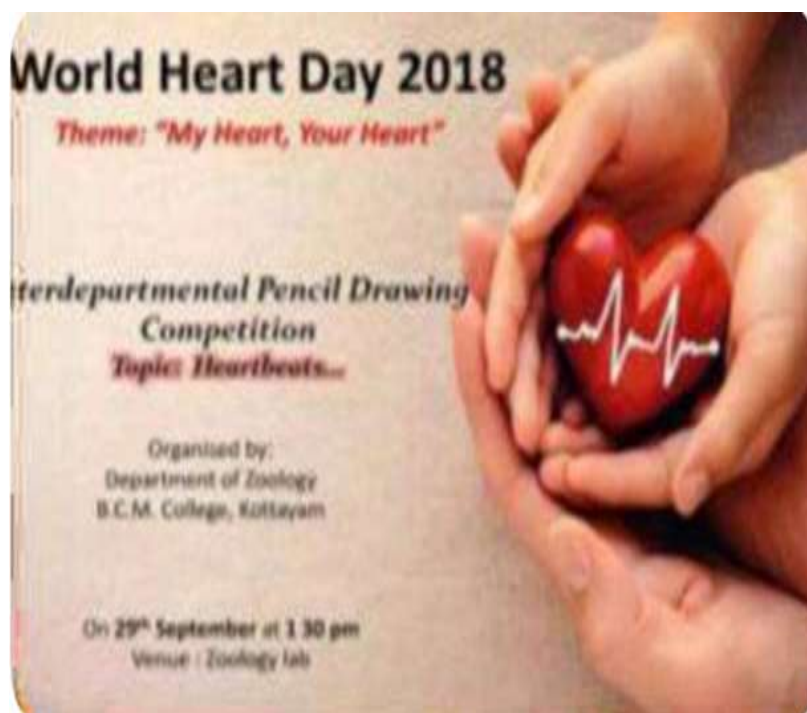

WORLD OTTER DAY



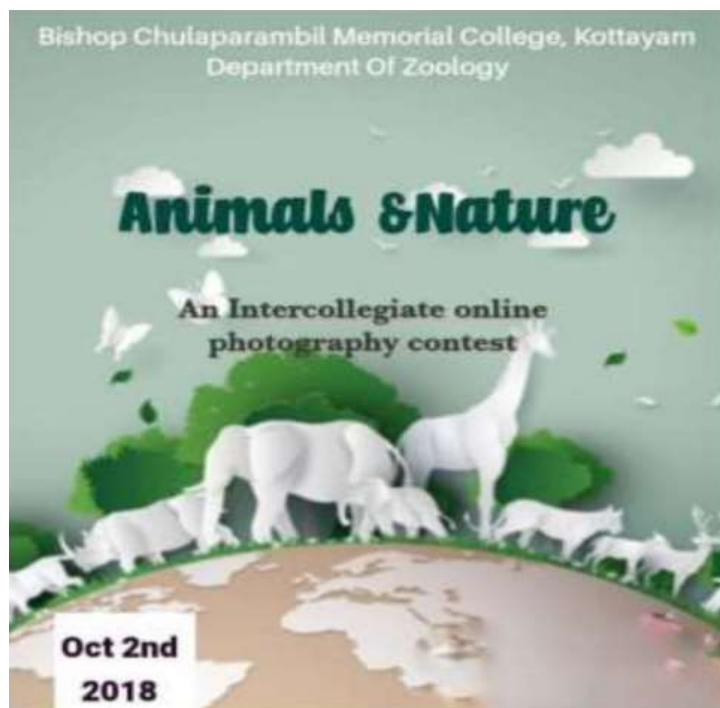

WORLD HEART DAY



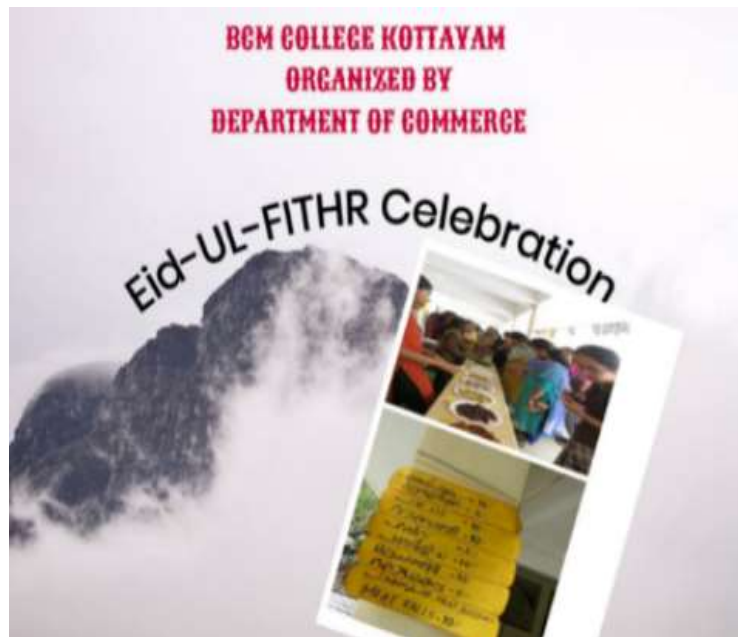
