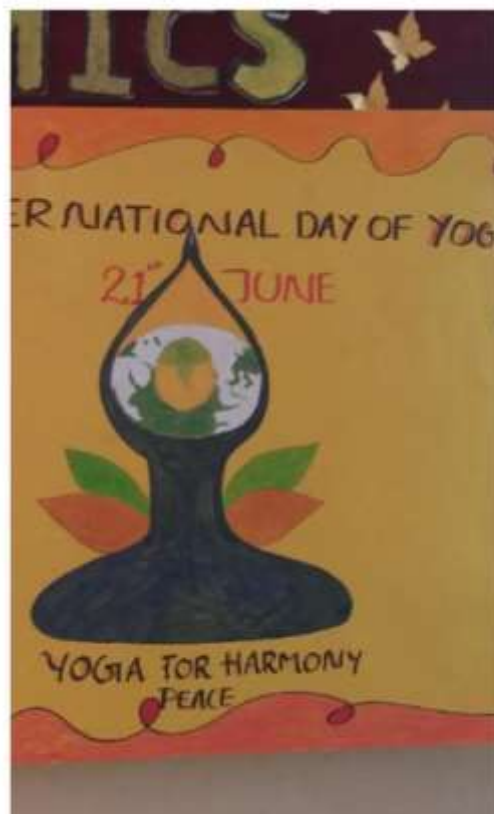
YOGA DAY

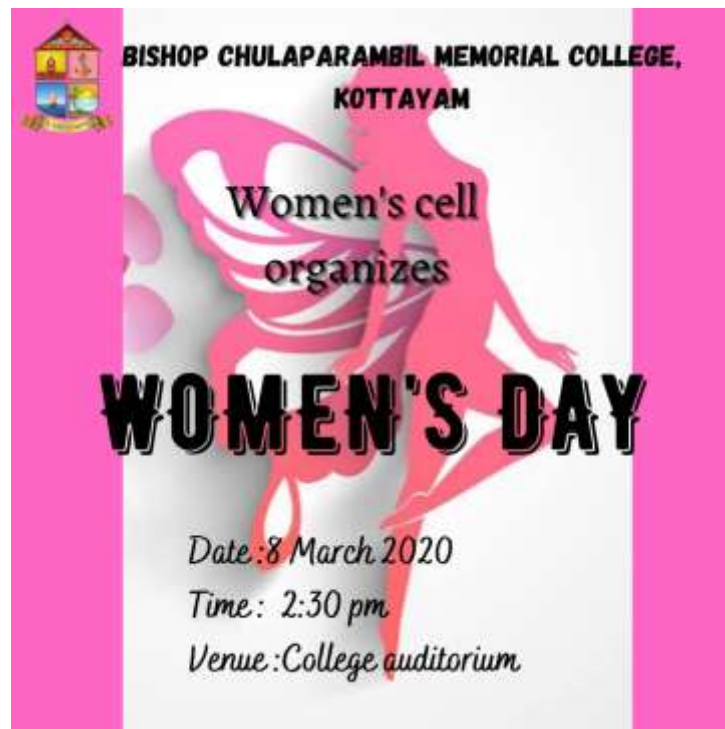


WORLD POPULATION DAY

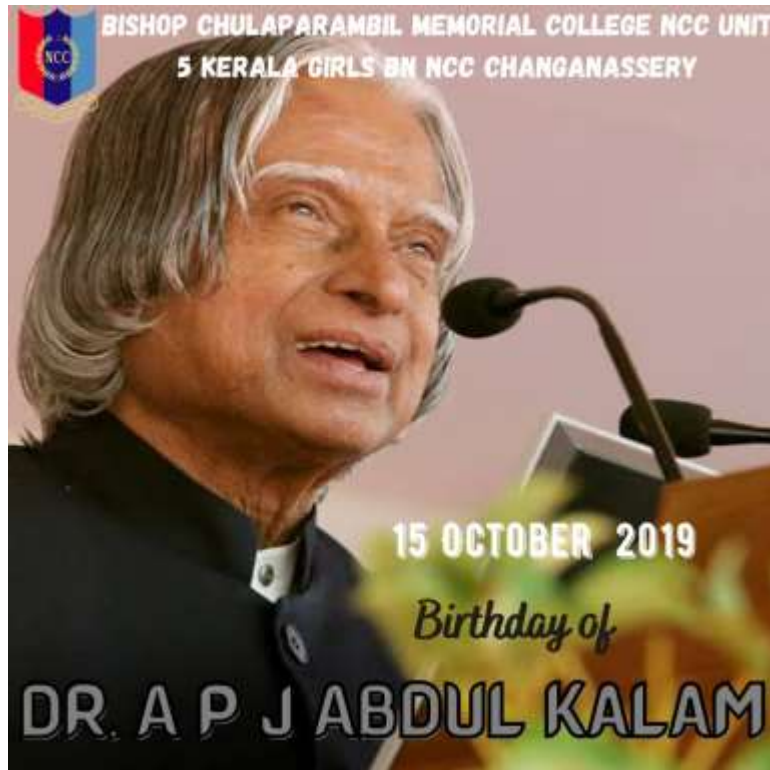


WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY

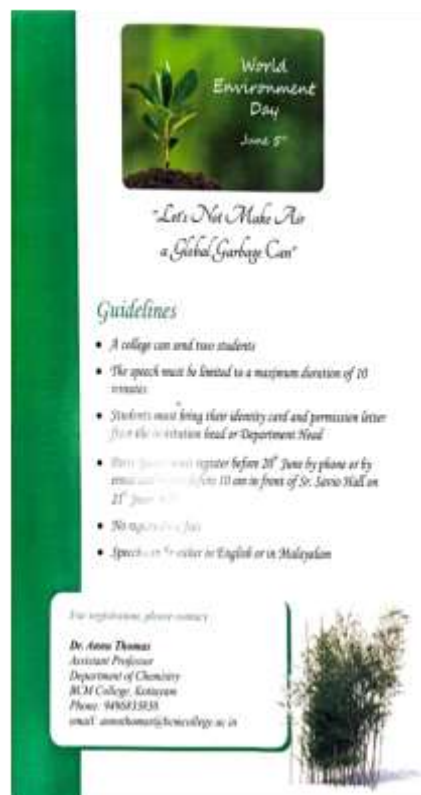
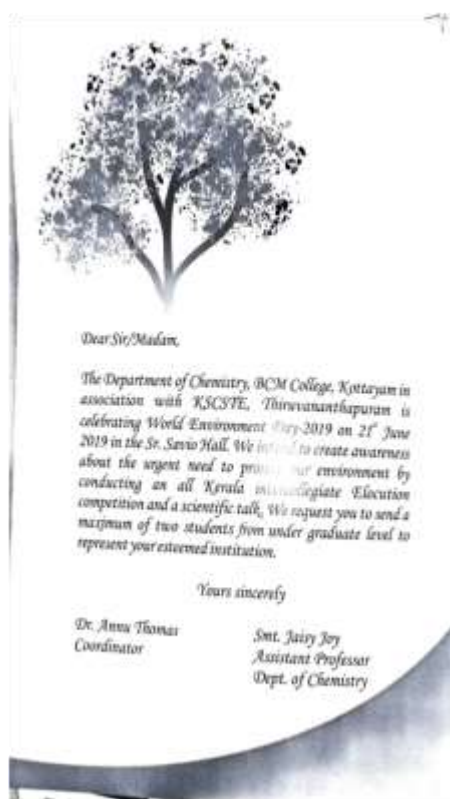
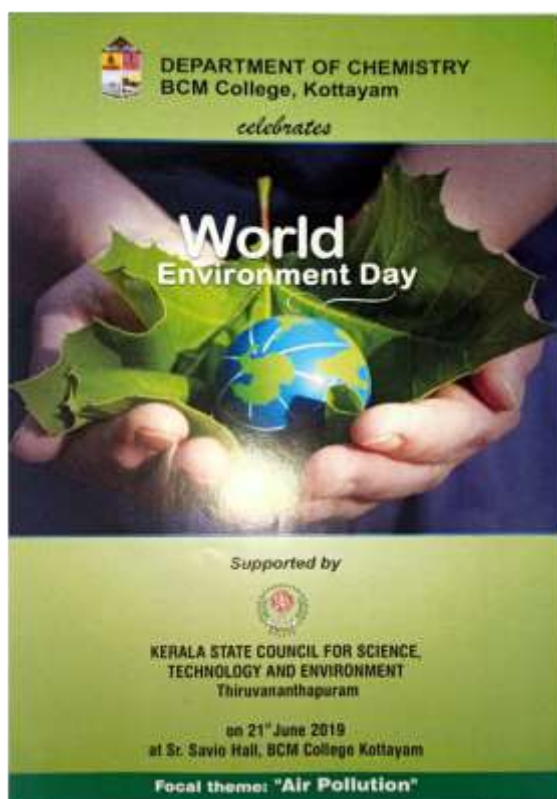
ENVIRONMENTAL DAY

AIDS DAY



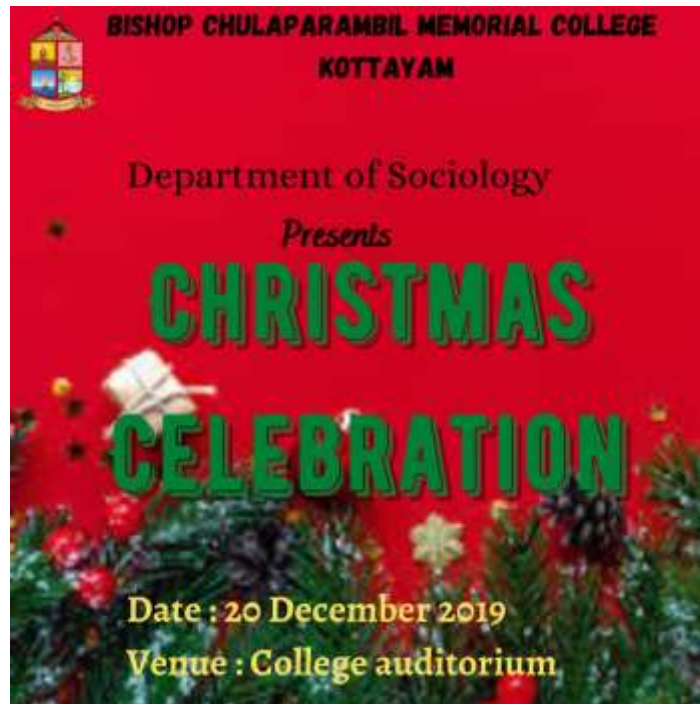

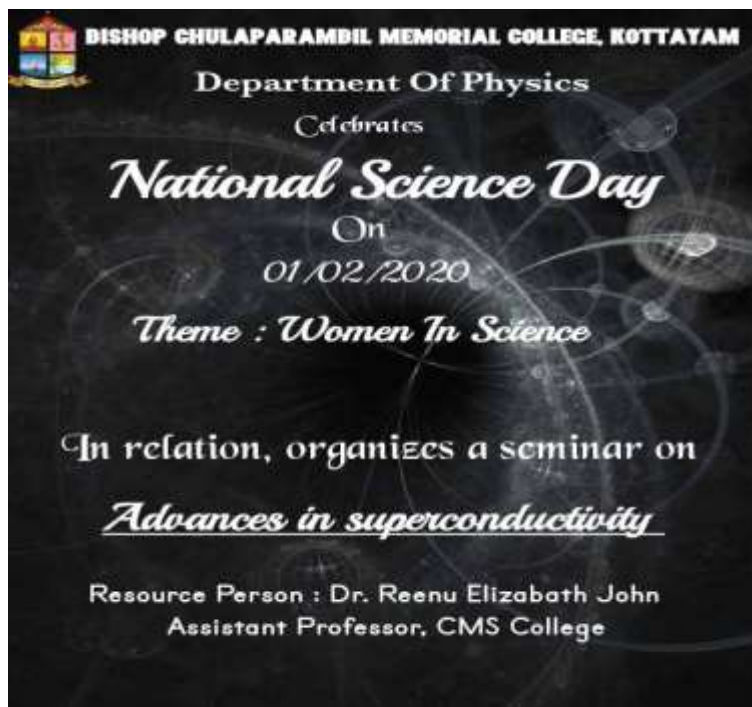


A view of the Teachers day celebration in various departments
