College Report 2020 - 2021

The College was established in the year 1955 by Mar Thomas Tharayil, who made the visionary zeal of his predecessor Bishop Chulaparambil a reality and liberated the women of South India from the patriarchal mores of the then society by establishing a college for the young women of the Knanaya Catholic community.

If the decades before had been about Bishop Chulaparambil Memorial College empowering girl students, 2020, the last year of the decade has produced liberated young women, no longer hesitant to speak up for their rights and fully ready to go that extra mile for themselves, their Alma Mater, their families and for the larger world. On the sixty fifth annual day, we can proudly claim that we have brought in changes within the teaching-learning activities with Outcome Based Education, a student-centric method.

The college reopened after summer vacation on 1st June 2020. The total strength of the college is 1764 students. There are 34 permanent teachers, 25 guest faculty, 30 unaided teachers and 15 none-teaching staffs. We have 16 UG programmes and 8 PG Programmes. Government of Kerala has sanctioned 2 crore rupees under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) during 2018-19 and releasing the amount in instalments. SO far we received 1 crore rupees from RUSA till now. The renovation work proposed under the project is almost finished. The college has renovated the College canteen with a facelift, renovated the roofings of the College auditorium, renovated the roofings of History/Economics Block under the project. New toilets with modern facility were added and a disabled friendly toilet is also constructed under the project. The tender process for installation of another 20KW solar power plant and rewiring of 12 rooms in 3 floors is also in the final phase. The only construction under the project – Extension of the UGC sponsored Women's Hostel is also started and expected to be completed in 6 months.

During the last year college has received concurrence from the Government for the appointment of three posts in English and a post in Economics. The process of appointment is underway.
