
2. FEEDBACK COMMITTEE (2019-20)

This committee acts as an advisory body to the council, allowing them to make changes based on the feedback collected from the previous year. The collected feedback is analysed and suggestions are made to the committee based on the report.

3. FEEDBACK METHODOLOGY

The feedback is collected from the alumni by distributing a well-structured questionnaire randomly. Feedback is collected through college-level as well as department-level alumni interactions. The structured questionnaire is get filled by spreading them during alumni meets. Such questionnaires are the primary source of alumni feedback in the feedback committee's hands. After collecting the feedback, it is put for further analysis, and the summary is submitted to IQAC for different implementation. Once the IQAC is convinced of the changes, they put it forward to the Governing Body, where the changes are implemented. The feedback summary report is submitted to MG University also.



5. FEEDBACK ANALYSIS OF ALUMNI



5.1. THE SYLLABUS HELPED YOU LEARN NEW SKILLS




43.3% of the students strongly agree that the syllabus helped you learn new skills, 29.8% agree, 14.9% had neutral response and 11.9% disagree with the statement.

5.2. THE SYLLABUS CREATED INTEREST IN ORDER TO PURSUE HIGHER STUDIES




49.2% of the students strongly agree that 'The syllabus created interest in order to pursue higher studies', 20.9% agree, 17.9% had neutral response and 12% disagree with the statement.

5.3. THE SYLLABUS WAS UPDATED ACCORDING TO RECENT TRENDS AND DEVELOPMENTS





5.4. EMPLOYABILITY IS GIVEN FOCUS





5.5. THE SYLLABUS IS SUITABLE FOR JOBS RELATED TO YOUR FIELD





5.6. WOULD YOU RECOMMEND THIS SYLLABUS TO OTHERS?





5.7. THE COURSE CURRICULUM FULFILLED YOUR EXPECTATIONS




49.2% of the alumni strongly agree that 'The course fulfilled your expectations', 37.3% agree, 6% had neutral response and 7.5% disagree with the statement.

5.8. THE SYLLABUS HAS RELEVANCE TO SOCIETAL NEEDS





5.9. THE SYLLABUS IMPARTS PRACTICAL KNOWLEDGE




Majority (73.1%) of the alumni responded 'yes' for the statement 'The syllabus imparts practical knowledge', 22.4% responded 'maybe' and only 4.5% responded 'no' to the statement.
