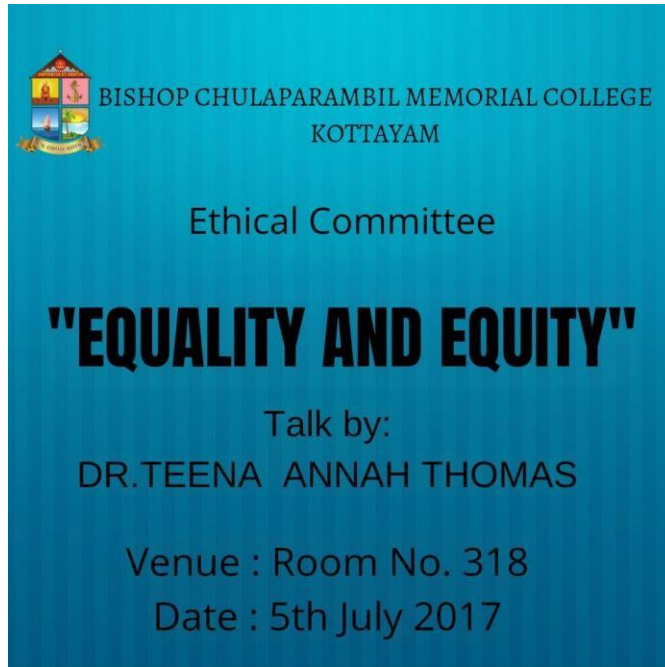

A session on “Equality and Equity” for the students

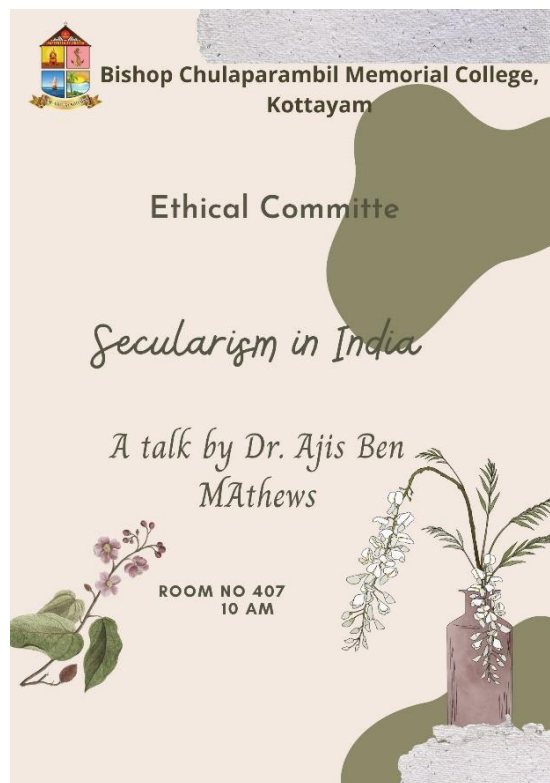

A session on “Secularism in India” for students

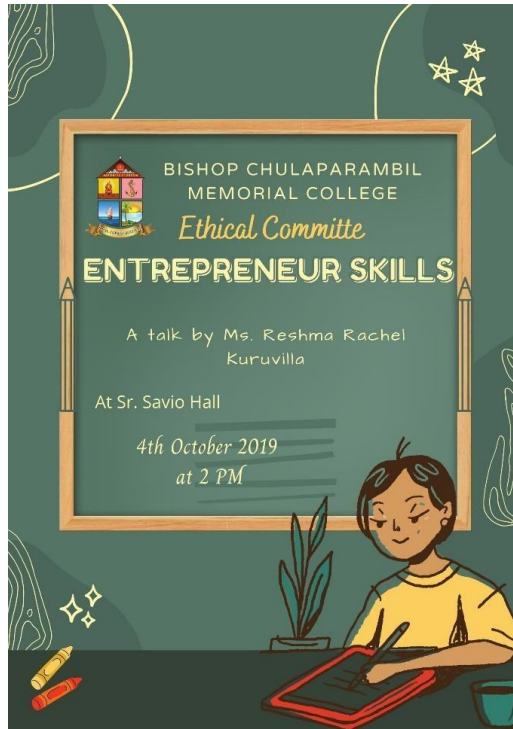
