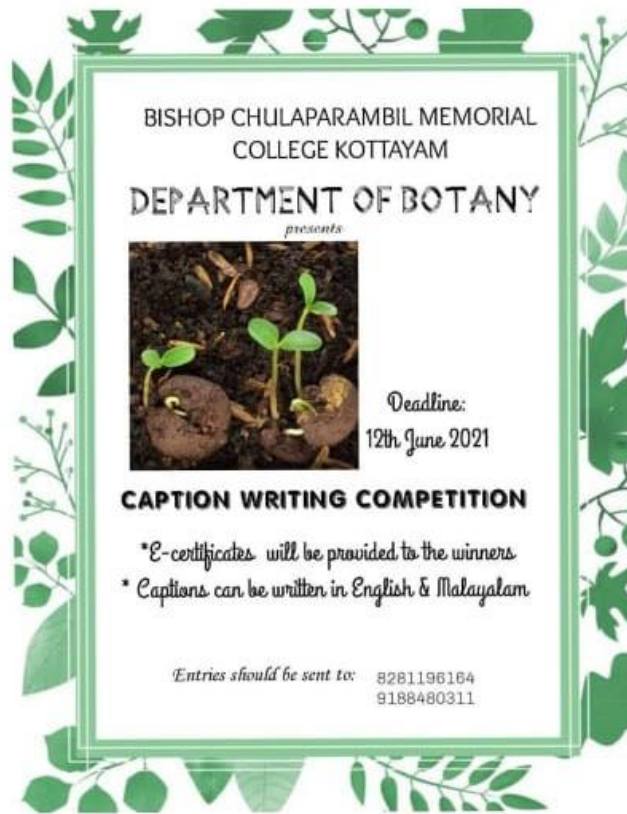

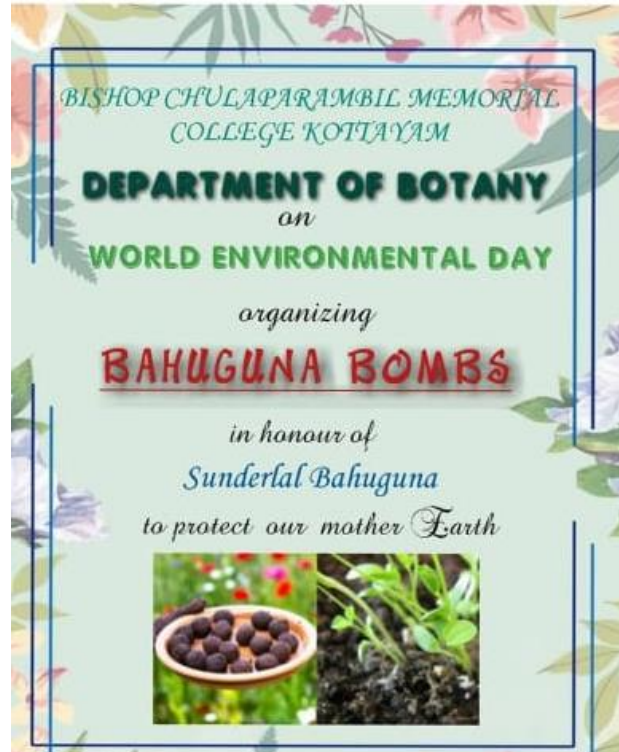

BAHUGUNA SEED BOMBS



As part of WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY, Department of Botany was organised 'BAHUGUNA SEED BOMBS' in respect to SUNDERAL BAHUGUNA, the Indian environmentalist.

Steps in the preparation of BAHUGUNA SEED BOMBS...


- 1.Prepare mud balls with mud-paste.
- 2.Insert viable seeds of suitable size into mud balls.
- 3.Cover seeds with surrounding mud-paste and shape them into round forms.
- 4.Place 'SEED BOMBS' over fairly large leaves like Banana, Colacasia or within the leaf sheath of Arecanut.

5. Dry the seed bombs partially so that anyone can handle them easily.
6. Cast them far and wide mainly in barren areas
7. Observe the growth of germinating seedlings periodically.





Students of 2nd DC and 3rd DC prepared seed bombs at their home and threw it in their yards . the program was recorded and was presented as a video presentation program.

The college organised an International lecture series From 14th September 2021 to 1st October 2021 named “VYKHARI – 2K21” via google meet.

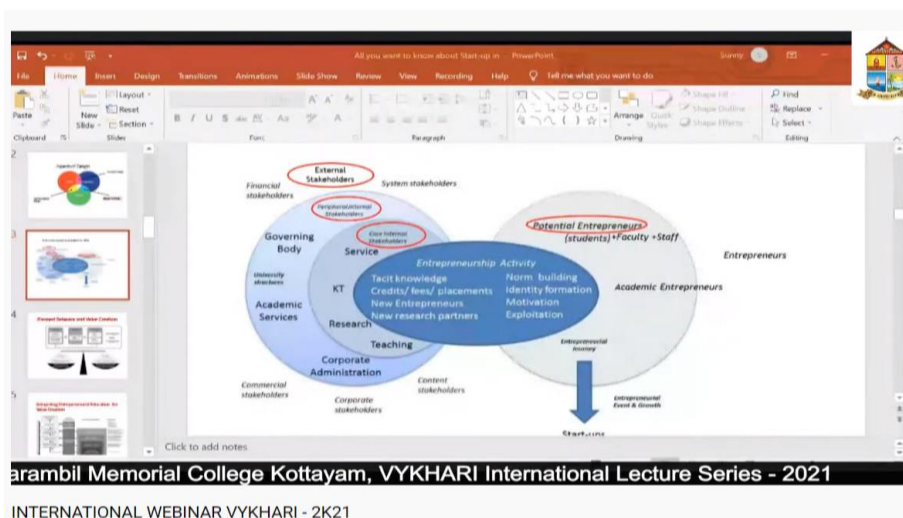

The program was conducted in accordance to international water day. The subject of the competition was “the last drop of water”. It was conducted at the botany lab from 8:30 am to 9:30 am.

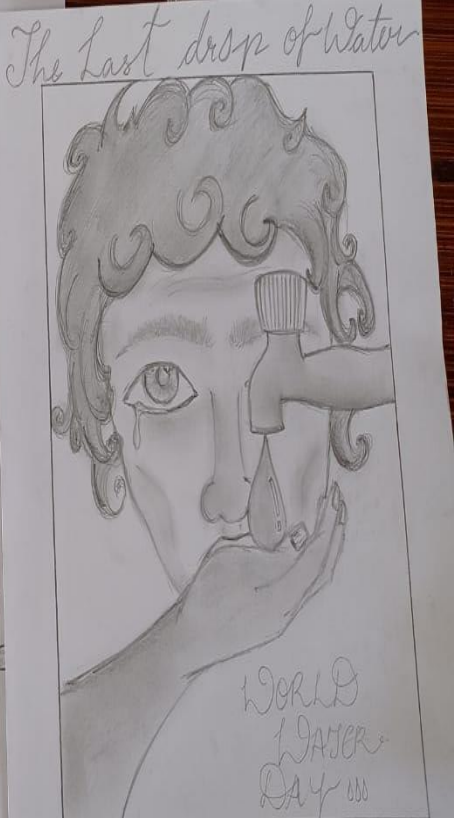
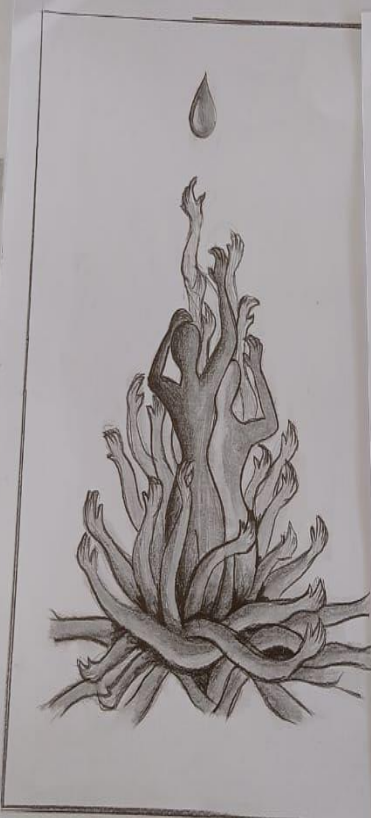

The theme of the competition was “Save Forest”

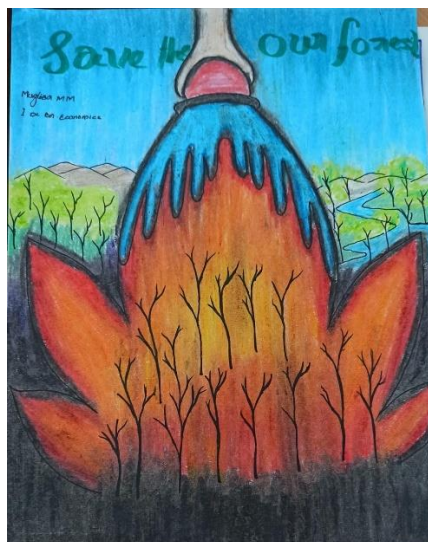
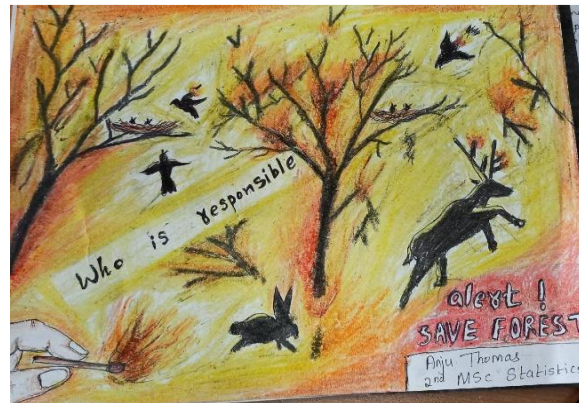

A collage making competition was held on 23rd march 2022 as a part of SIERRA 2K22 . The program was based on international forest day . The theme of the competition was forest fire.

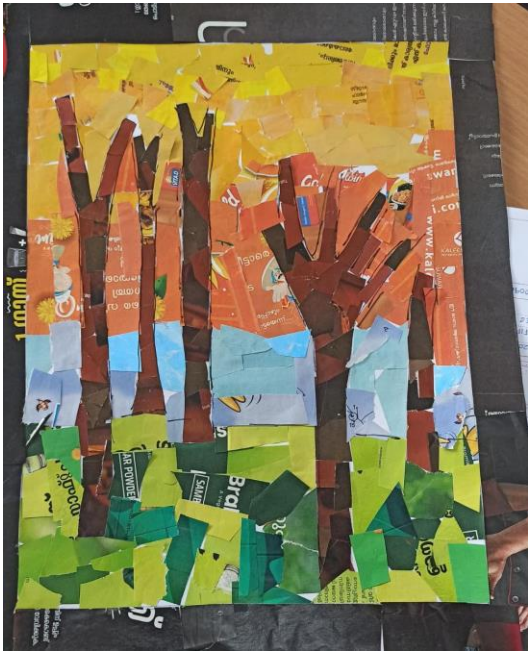

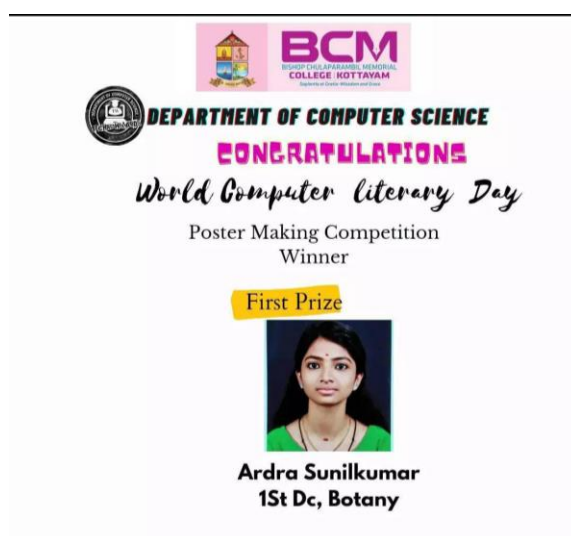






ACHIEVEMENTS
