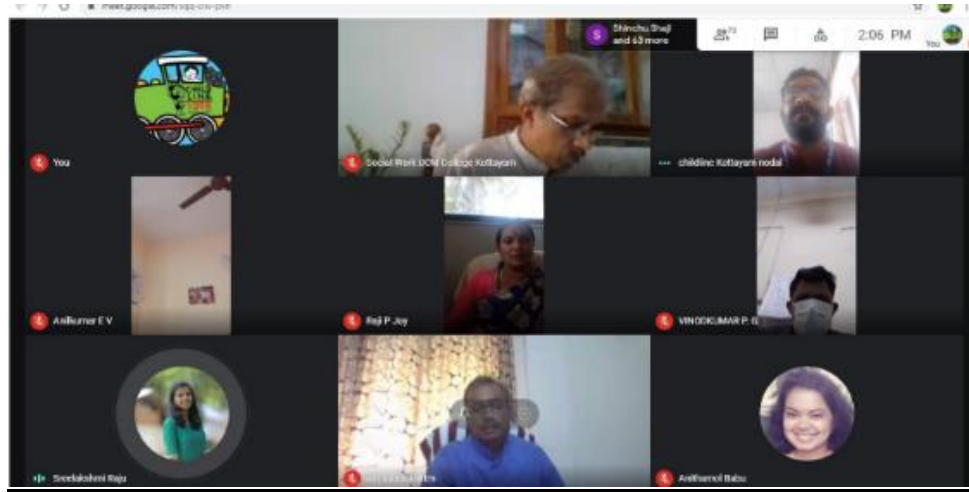
JUNE 12- Anti Child Labour Day

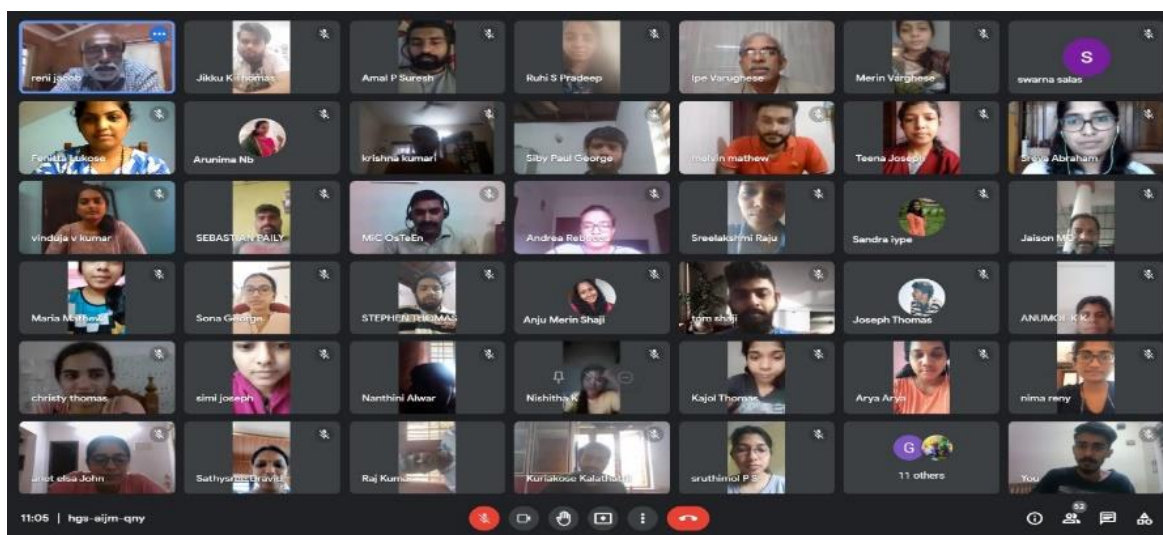

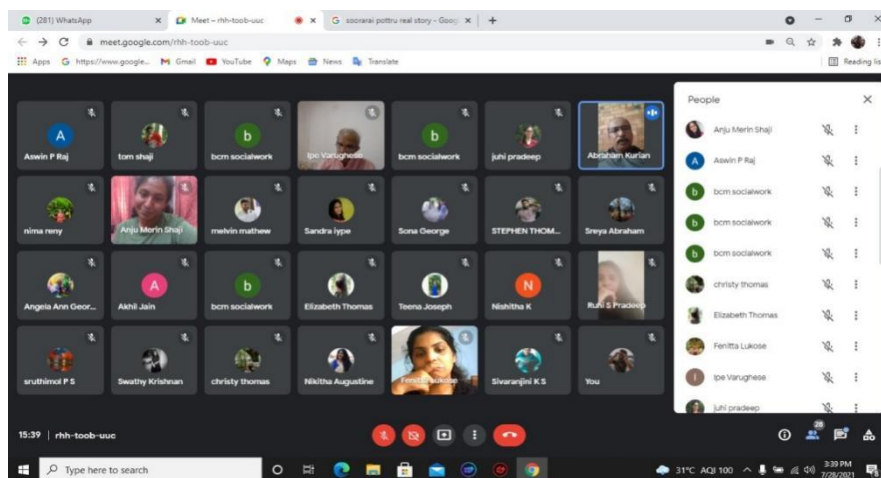
Orientation session for parents

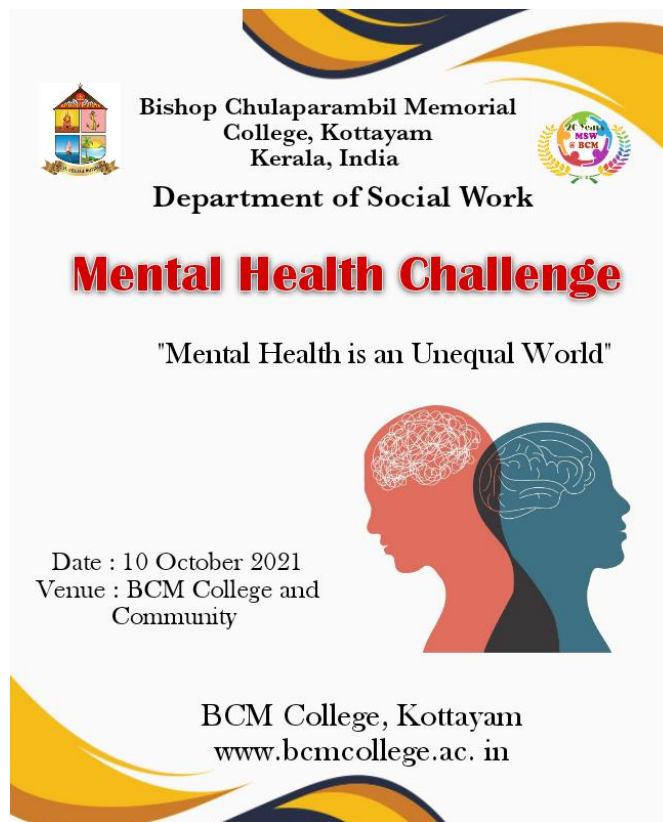

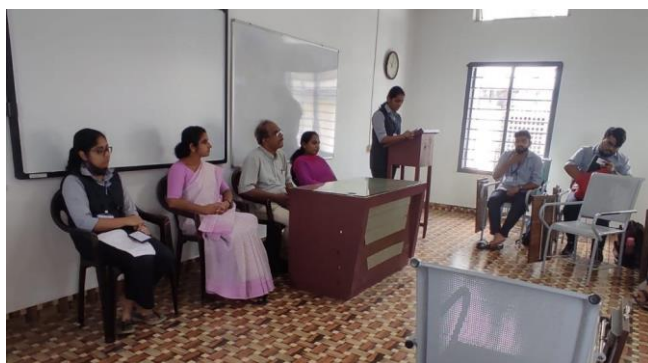

Observation of Constitution Day





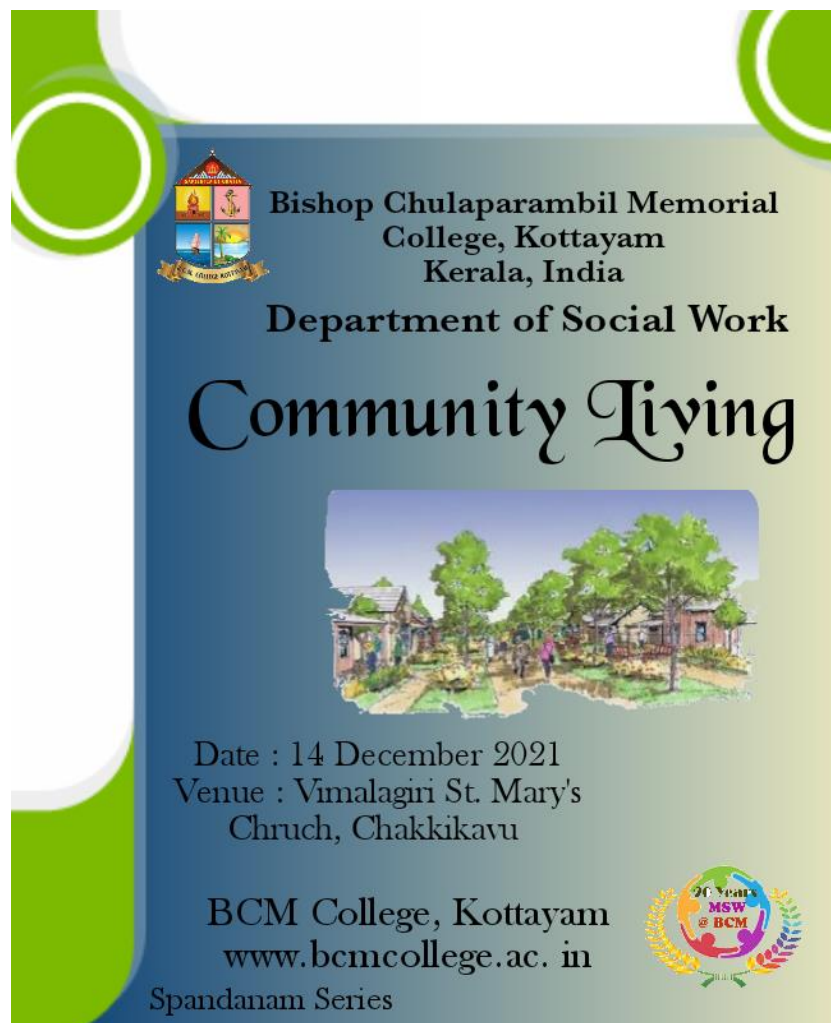


Living in the Community and Learning Programme at Vimalagiri


Department of social work has organized an awareness session for the women on the topic 'Importance of Career guidance in education' for the women in Chakkikkavu village.

Theatre Workshop 2022 Batch 2020-2022 & 2021-2023

Dept. of Social Work conducted a workshop on theatre forms on 5-6 May 2022 at Christeen Centre, Kalathilpady. At 9:00 a.m., Dr. Ipe Varghese, head of the social work department, BCM College in Kottayam, led an interactive session. PSW Shynoj O V and his crew of nine members started the workshop. He began by introducing himself and providing a clear understanding of what a theatre workshop entails. Dr. Ipe Varghese, Sr. Sheena M U, Ms Gayathridas and Ms. Ancy Francis stayed with the group.

He started the class by gathering the students in a huge circle and teaching them a few dance routines to perform, which two students applauded each other for. The pupils were then given the opportunity to do a pair dance to a Goan tune. Later he divided the students into five groups named:

- Kadambari Theatres
- Carnival Theatres
- Sarangi Theatres
- Urvashi Theatres
- Kalamandalam Theatres

Each group has 10-11 students, and all competitions are held amongst these groups after they have been divided. The first competition required participants to do a dance to the music provided by Mr. Shynoj sir and his crew. Then each group was given a stick and told to envision it as something else, such as a human, a rope, etc.

After that, he gave each group a topic and 15 minutes to develop a skit. Then each group performed the skit, with other groups and judges providing critical feedback. In between, Mr. Shynoj discussed many aspects of a stage, such as the centre, back centre, down centre, right centre, and so on. Later, TSW also studied and practised singing the "social workers anthem."

Workshop continued after supper. TSW was then given the opportunity to spot dance for three songs, and they were required to compose a skit for each group based on these three songs. Each group had its own set of songs. Five groups brought on five outstanding performances. The first day session ended at 12:00 a.m. with evaluations from five representatives from five different groups. TSW went to sleep after the prayer.

The second day started with a warm up session at 5:30 A.M. in which yoga, singing and dance session took place. Mr Shynoj lead the session with Mr. Rakesh. Both of them also enlightened us about flashmob rules, and what all to keep in mind while we perform one.

Post breakfast at 8:30, all went outside for an open session. we played games, the aim was how to be creative and mould old games into something interesting and engaging. the game lasted for about half n hour, after which Mr Shynoj briefed us about our next session and that was news reading. the activity was to find hidden news and present it on stage like a news channel does.

The activities were performed by groups, that were divided on Day 1 itself. Each group had about half an hour to prepare and 10 mins to present the news on stage with advertisements. Each of the group presented the news reporting play, each group was also assigned with a groomer to help with the play. After the play, the session was concluded with feedback of the groomers and Mr. Shynoj.

After 1 PM a new session started in which each group was assigned a task for field. like community living, nomadic life, playing transgenders, sales people. etc. The groomers guided each group with all the details and helped them. The activity started at 2:00 PM, and lasted for around 1.5 hours. the groomers also visited all the groups in between to check on them.

We reached back to our place by 4, had a short tea break. following which headed to our next session, in which a folk music play was introduced to us, again each group had groomers and we all scripted and went for the practice.

At 6:00 P.M the team were asked to present the play, all the groups got ready for the play and started the play at 6:00 PM itself. All the groups performed and there were all positive feedback from the groomers and Mr. Shynoj.

Soon after the play was over, the team were sent for Dinner at 7:45 and asked to come back for the next and final session for the day. which was a tele- shoot. Everyone reached the venue on time, and each group was called on stage and assigned roles. everyone was taken in frame, no one was left out. Mr. Shynoj lead the session guided each member on what to do, and how to perform. the session ended by 10:30. following which there was an evaluation, in which one member from every group shared the experiences they gained in these two days. All the groomers And Mr Shynoj also shared their feedback and experience with us. At last Dr. Ipe Varughese also shared his views on the Theatre Workshop. The day ended with a group photo session, and cleaning the venue. The finished with national anthem.

Ms. J. obina of 2nd year MSW, BCM college.

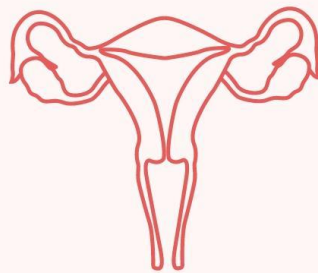

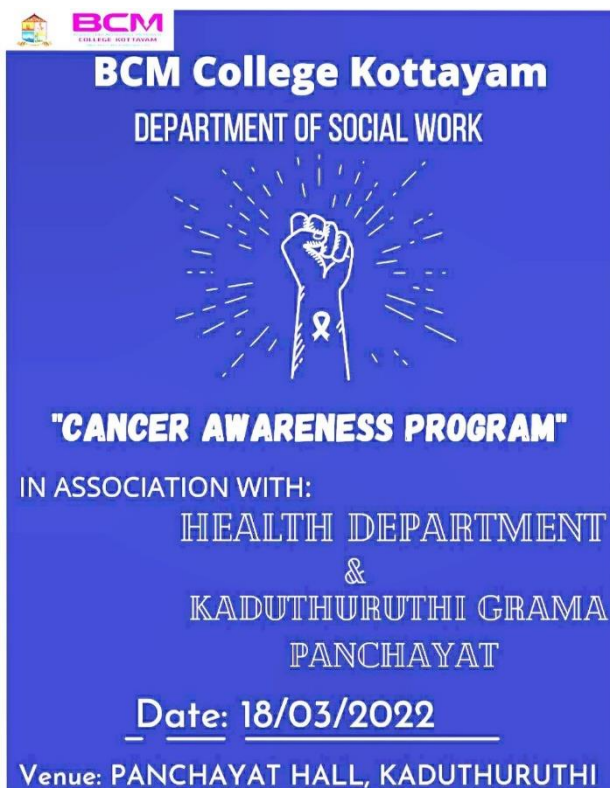
Damage Assessment during Flood and Landslide at Koottikkal
