



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



Between

Kadambari Memorial College of Science and Management, Kathmandu, Nepal

And

Bishop Chulaparambil Memorial College, Kottayam, Kerala, India

This Agreement is made and entered into on the date of the final signature hereto, by and between Kadambari Memorial College of Science and Management, hereinafter referred as **Kadambari Memorial College** and **Bishop Chulaparambil Memorial College, Kottayam, Kerala, India** hereinafter referred to as **B.C.M College**.

I. The Parties will jointly develop cooperative educational and research programs for faculty and Students of the two institutions within the frame work of this agreement. The cooperative activities to be covered by this agreement may include faculty and student exchanges, study abroad, intensive language programs, collaborative research programs, seminars and workshops, and service program.

II. Each activity to be performed under this agreement will be undertaken pursuant to an addendum that will contain the specific terms and conditions governing the activity. These terms and conditions will be mutually agreed upon by the two institutions on a case by case basis.

III. Each institution will be responsible for seeking funds to support its involvement in the cooperative activities contemplated under this agreement, and all such activities will be dependent upon the budgetary appropriations of the parties.

IV. All activities developed here under will be in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations of the home and host institutions, and all applicable national, state and local laws, rules and regulations.

V. B.C.M College appoints principal, Prof. Josephina Simon and Kadambari Memorial College appoints its principal, Ms. Pradipta Kadambari to coordinate the development and implementation of this agreements.

VI. This agreement will be in effect for a period of five (5) years beginning with the 2018-19 academic year and will be automatically renewed for successive five years periods unless either institutions gives the order a written notices of its desire to terminate or revise the agreement six month prior to the other party may terminate the agreement provided that such termination will not affect the completion of any activity underway at the time or any previously advertised activity in which commitments to university students or faculty have been made.

VII. All modifications to this agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Whereas Kadambari Memorial College and B.C.M College desire to engage in cooperative educational and research activities, for the mutual benefit of both institutions, the parties have agreed upon the following possibilities of collaboration:

1. Mutual exchange of faculty members between the schools to promote co-teaching course, joint research and field action projects.
2. Field placement of the students.
3. Possibility of joint cross cultural research in the areas of common interest to both the schools.
4. Joint publications-Both the schools can publish research based articles in journals published by both the institutions and in other journals.
5. Organize joint Seminars, Conferences and workshops on relevant topics.
6. Facilitating organization exposure visits.
