BEAMS was successful in ensuring the participation of our alumnae in the alumnae interaction session of NAAC Peer Team on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2023.





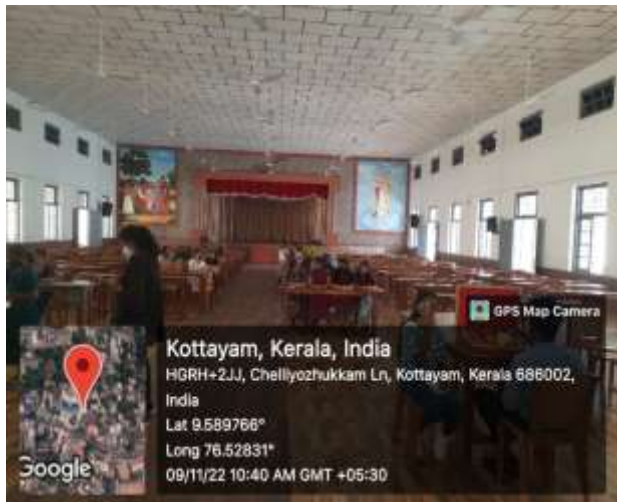




- Mono Act by Minu Anna Mathew on BEAMS DAY. She was the College Union Chair Person and M.G University First Prize winner for Mono Act
