
1.WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

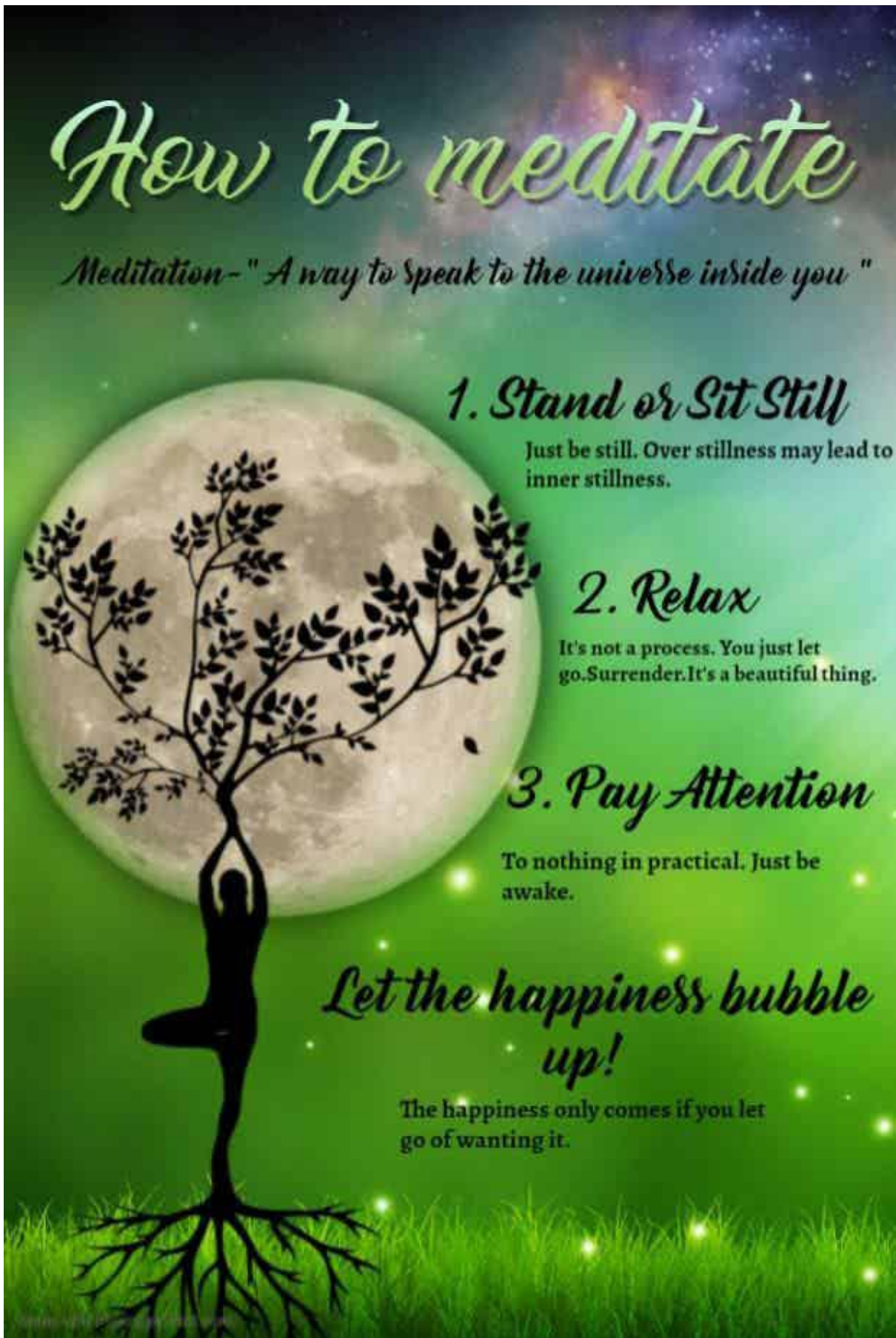



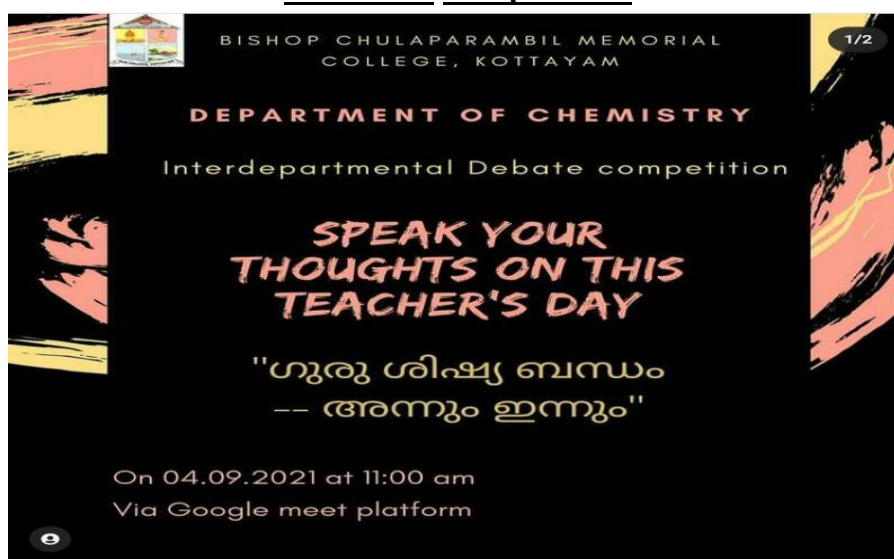

GLIMPSE

Dr. Prashanth W. Menezes is currently a group head of inorganic materials for energy catalysis at the department of chemistry, Technical University of Berlin (TU-Berlin) as well as Helmholtz Center for Materials and Energy (HZB) in Germany. His research focuses on the design, development, and structural understanding of novel unconventional catalysts in heterogeneous catalysis, especially in the area of redox oxygen catalysis, (photo)electrocatalytic water splitting as well as electrochemical redox reactions. He has published over 100 high-impact original research articles (over 4000 citations) and book chapters, and even has three patents to his credit. He has delivered talks in numerous conferences around the world and has received several awards throughout his research career. He was also a distinguished speaker at the United Nations Initiatives for Sustainable Chemistry. Further, his innovation based on the non-noble concept for wastewater treatment was also highlighted at the German research and Innovation Forum which is under development towards the founding a start-up. Last year, he was figured among the top two per cent scientists in a global list compiled by the prestigious Stanford University. Prashanth obtained his PhD from the renowned Max-Planck Institute in Dresden, Germany in solid state and structural chemistry and then moved to the prestigious Technical University of Munich to conduct his post doctoral research in the direction of inorganic chemistry with a focus on novel materials. He conducted research at the reputed Indian Institute for Science, Bangalore, before moving to Germany to pursue his doctoral studies.

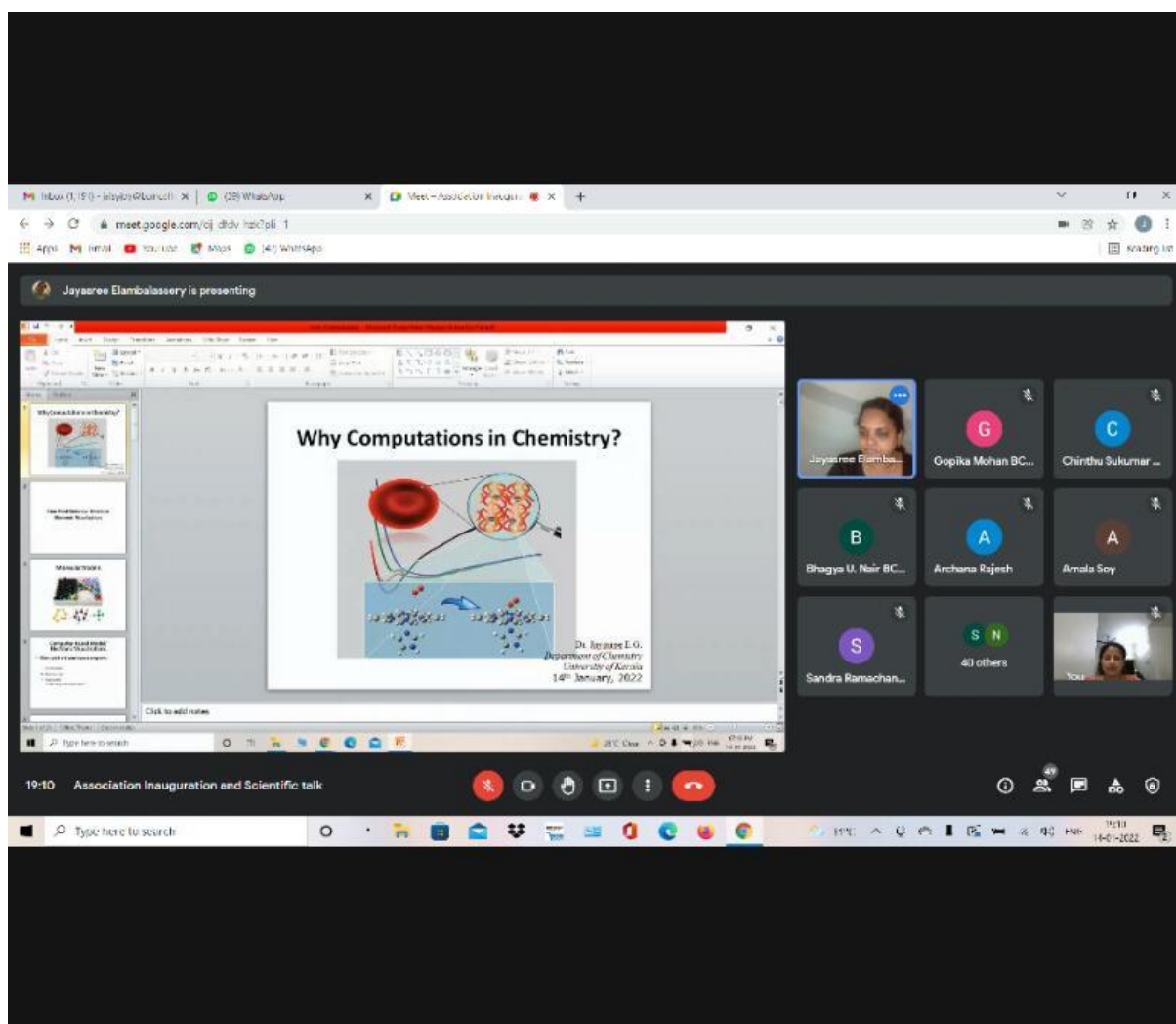

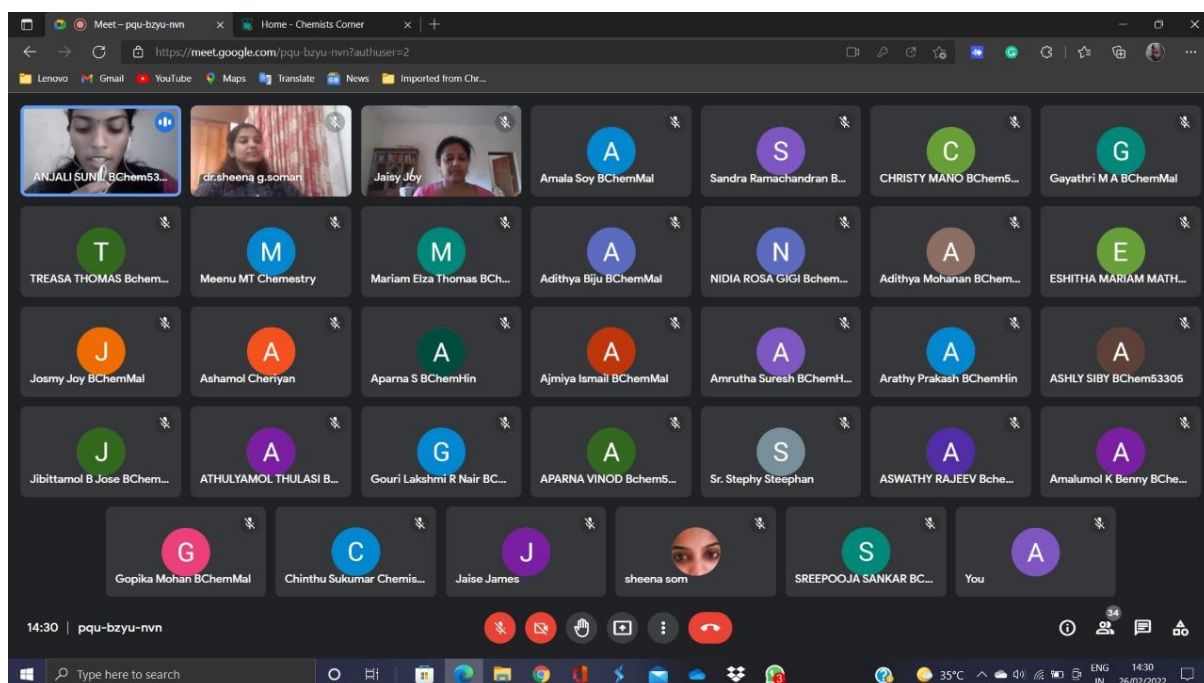
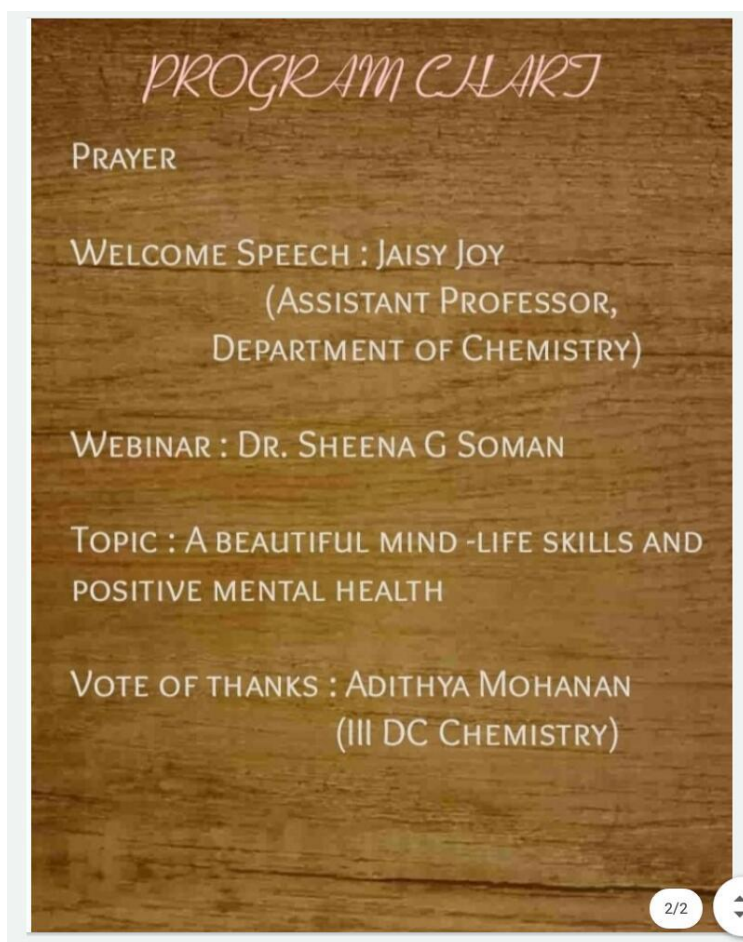

3. Webinar on Positive Thinking

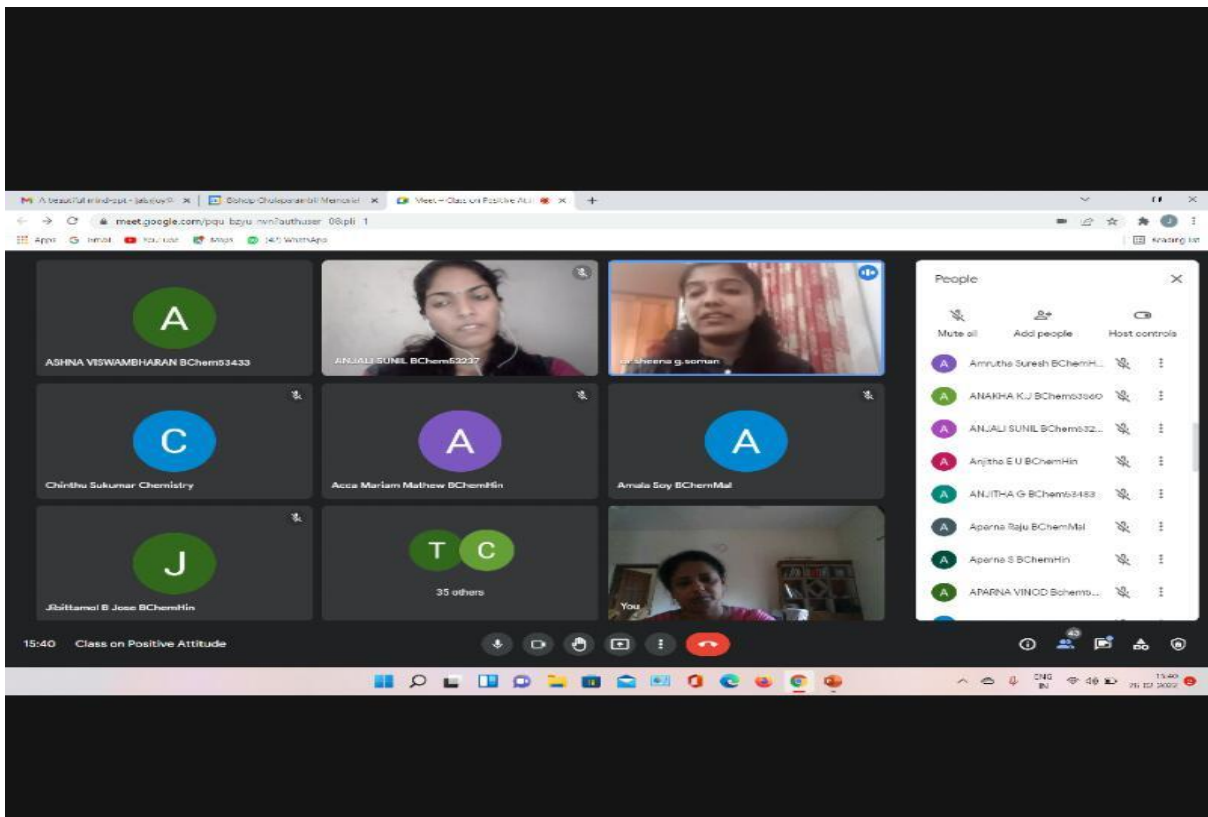
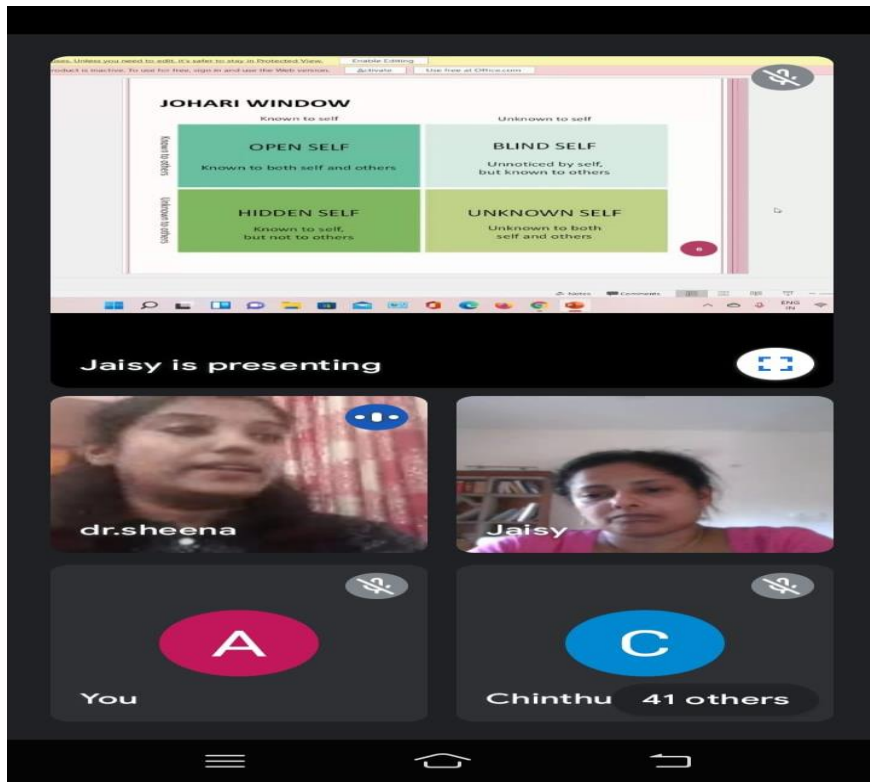

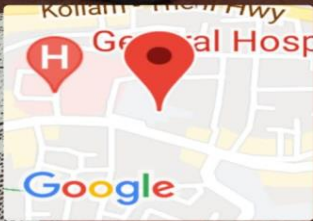
1. SR. MONFORT SOFT SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME

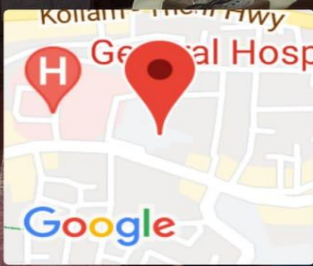

The training provided some very concrete and easy-to-follow tips to crack interviews and to write a perfect resume.





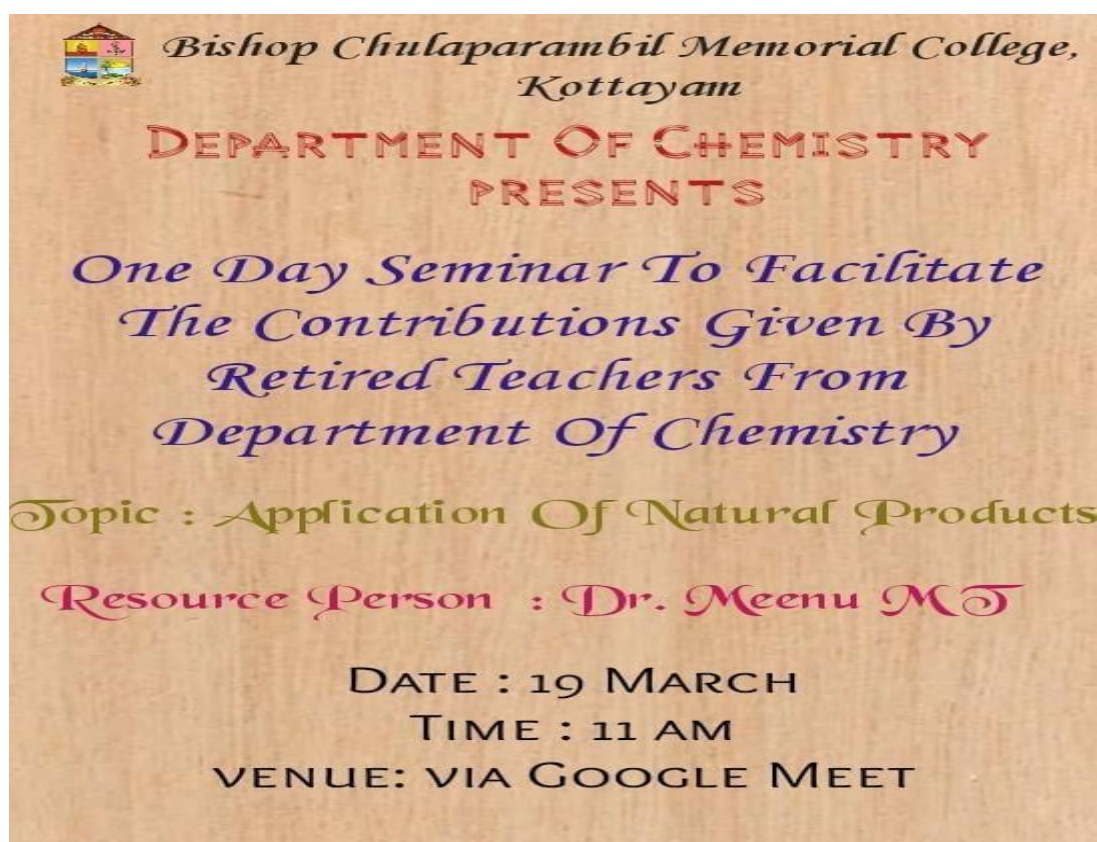
