

2. Talk By Dr. Annu Thomas






1) WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY – JUNE 5


1) XAVIER LEADERSHIP CENTRE [XLC]



5) MANUSCRIPT MAGAZINE




13) INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT


iii) <u>AWARENESS VIDEO ON INTERNATIONAL</u> <u>GIRL CHILD DAY</u>




iii) <u>MATHCAM - ONLINE PHOTOGRAPHY</u> <u>CONTEST</u>

i) ONAM CELEBRATION


