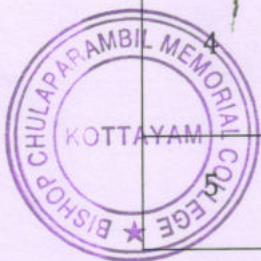
Sub:- Monitoring Committee for Research Presentations and Publications

Coordinators are required to submit the presentation schedule for the period of July to October 2023 before July 26, 2023.

Participation: All Bishop Chulaparambil Memorial College faculty members are encouraged to participate in these sessions actively. We believe that each one of you has unique contributions that can significantly impact your respective fields of study.

Format: Each presenter will be allotted a designated time to present their research work not less than 20 minutes, followed by a question-and-answer session. The presentations are expected to be well-structured and focus on the research methodology, key findings, and potential implications of the research.

Evaluation and Feedback: Concerned panel will evaluate the presentations, taking into consideration the content, presentation skills, and research significance. Constructive feedback will be provided to the presenters to help them to enhance the quality and impact of their research work. Coordinators are required to submit the report to the Research Development Cell every quarter.

Publication Opportunities: Based on the quality and significance of the research presented, concerned coordinators encourage faculty members to publish their work in reputed journals.

Recognition and Awards: To motivate and acknowledge outstanding contributions, the RDC will institute awards for the best Publications
