The healthcare services are efficiently coordinated under the leadership of Sr. Dr. Remya Simon, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, who serves as the Teacher-in-Charge. She oversees the functioning of the Cell and ensures that quality healthcare support is consistently provided. Ms. Taniya Kuruvila, Nurse In-Charge, manages the day-to-day medical services, including administering first aid, maintaining medical records, monitoring students requiring observation, washing bedsheet and assisting in emergency care.

The institution has established two well-maintained sick rooms to accommodate students who require rest or immediate medical attention. These rooms are equipped with essential medical supplies, beds, medicines, a BP apparatus, and other necessary amenities to ensure patient comfort and care. Strict hygiene protocols are followed to maintain cleanliness and prevent the spread of infections. Bed sheets are washed daily, and the rooms are regularly sanitized to uphold high health standards.

Essential medicines and medical supplies are procured through the PD Account to ensure continuous availability. The procurement process follows established guidelines to maintain quality and timely replenishment of stock. The institution also collaborates with Caritas Hospital for additional medical support and essential facilities when required.
